## WILLIAMS SETTLEMENT ANNUAL HEARING OF THE PUBLIC

The Williams Settlement requires all boards to hold a hearing each September regarding sufficiency of instructional materials and to adopt a sufficiency resolution by the eighth week of the school year, determining that every pupil, including English learners, has sufficient textbooks and/or instructional materials that are aligned to the content standards in the following subjects that are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum framework adopted by the State Board of Education: mathematics, science, history-social science, reading/language arts. The public hearing will be 10 days from posting of this notice which will be on September 8, 2020.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS, SCHOOL FACILITIES, AND TEACHER ASSIGNMENTS

State law requires the following:

- 1. There should be sufficient textbooks and instructional materials. Each student, including English learners, must have textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home.
- 2. School facilities must be clean, safe, and maintained in good repair.
- 3. There should be a teacher assigned to each class at the beginning of the school year. The teacher should have the proper credential and subject matter training to teach the class, including training to teach English learners if present.
