Tuesday April 21, 2020, at San Pasqual Union School

- Meeting called to order at 5:00 p.m. to allow public comment on closed session agenda items. Members Baker, Czerwonka, Merz, and Zdunich were present. Superintendent Burroughs and recording secretary, Pamela Hansen, were also present. No one addressed the Board.
- Adjournment at 5:04 for closed session.

Regular Session

- Reconvene regular meeting at 5:33.
- Report from Closed Session: Board decided to postpone Item E until the Board can meet in person.
- Public Hearing: Rebecca Nutile made a written statement with concerns about the distance learning platform Acellus. She specifically had concerns about the founder's credibility and the school's academic credentials.
- Member Czerwonka made a motion to approve the current agenda and minutes from the 3/10/2020 regular meeting and the 3/13/2020 emergency meeting. Member Spivey seconded the motion. Motion passed 5/0.
- PTO Update:
 - o Spring Book Fair and Lunch on the Lawn generated approximately \$6,000 allowing each full time teacher to purchase \$50.00 in books for their classrooms.
 - o gARTen day postponed
 - o Variety Show postponed
 - o Yearbook team working on 2019-2020 yearbook and hoping to include a "virtual signature" option.
- Foundation Update:
 - o Gala postponed
 - o Planning for a fall golf event.
- Superintendent Report:
 - o LCAP Waiting to hear updated timelines
 - BUDGET Current timelines are still in place. Funded Chromebooks for kids though Foundation. Funded distance learning software though grant monies.
 Purchased hotspots for the few families that do not have internet access. Due to closure we lost a significant amount of revenue from preschool and kids club.
 - o Beginning fall registration for new students.
 - o Superintendent /Board Goal #4 Highly Effective Student-Centered staff.
 - o Kid-Centered focus immediately upon school shut down

- Thoughtful approach, focused on social-emotional issues, needs of families and educational opportunities.
- o Positive response to kids and parent's needs.
- o Virtual Inspirational Team of the Month Middle School Team
- o Mrs. Zduinch received North Island Credit Union Spring Teacher Grant for her outstanding work in service of students.
- Superintendent Burroughs and Assistant Principal Lee provided an update on distance learning and pandemic response. Specifically, they shared that while the current focus is supporting students through distance learning, future planning will require multiple scenarios and will rely heavily upon health department guidance.
- Member Czerwonka made a motion to approve Resolution R#19-20-13 to modify graduation/promotion requirements for students currently enrolled. Member Zdunich seconded the motion. Motion passed 5/0.
- Member Czerwonka made a motion to approve R#19-20-12 to increase statutory school fees on new development projects. Member Merz seconded the motion. Motion passed 5/0
- Member Zdunich made a motion to approve the agreement with California State University San Marcos to provide teaching experience through clinical practice to teacher candidates enrolled in teacher training. Member Spivey seconded the motion. Motion passed 5/0.
- Member Spivey made a motion to approve the policy manual changes as presented. Member Zdunich seconded the motion. Motion passed 5/0.
