- Reading positive messages brings joy to you and you spread it out to friends
- 70.6% of young people say they have seen bullying in their schools
- 49% of children between 4th 12th grade reported being bullied at least once during the past month.
- By high school, less than 30% of girls feel confident and positive about themselves
- Girls are 3 times more likely than boys to have a negative body image
