#### **BOARD OF EDUCATION MINUTES**

Tuesday January 14, 2020, at San Pasqual Union School

- Meeting called to order at 5:00 p.m. to allow public comment on closed session agenda items. All members were present. Superintendent Burroughs and recording secretary, Pamela Hansen, were also present. No one addressed the Board.
- Adjournment at 5:05 for closed session.

#### **Regular Session**

- Regular meeting called to order at 5:35.
- Report from Closed Session: No action was taken.
- Public Hearing: No one requested to address the Board.
- Member Czerwonka made a motion to approve the current agenda and minutes from the 12/17/19 meeting. Member Zdunich seconded the motion. Motion passed 5/0.
- The Board held a hearing of the public regarding the pre mapping of trustee areas. This was the 5<sup>th</sup> public hearing and the 3<sup>rd</sup> post map hearing. There was no public comment on the pre mapping process or selection.
- Member Zdunich made a motion to approve resolution #R19-20-07 recommending that
  the San Diego County Committee on school district organization approve and establish
  Trustee Areas from which the San Pasqual Union School District trustees will be elected
  in a "by trustee" area election process. Member Merz seconded the motion. Motion
  passed 4/1. Member Spivey voted against the resolution
- Superintendent Burroughs gave a presentation on Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS), the new middle school opportunity hour, and our new social worker supports. (Available on the SPU website)
- Superintendent Burroughs gave an update on the Harvest Hills Development (formally Safari Highlands). (Available on the SPU website)
- Superintendent Report:
  - o The District has shared the California Healthy kids and LCAP surveys with students and families to get feedback on school climate and areas that need improvement.
  - o 5<sup>th</sup> grade students are looking to form a safety patrol. Looking for guidance from our School Resource Officer (SRO).
  - o Inspirational Employee for December is Joanne Wang.
  - A. Superintendent Burroughs gave a presentation on the SPU Board and Superintendent Goal 2 Safe, Clean, and Well-Maintained School Facility and Campus. (Available on the SPU website)
- Member Spivey excused himself early from the meeting.

- Superintendent Burroughs gave a presentation and the Board was presented with the first read of the comprehensive safety plan. (Available on the SPU website)
