- Adjournment at 5:05 for closed session.
- Regular meeting called to order at 5:37. All members were present. Superintendent Burroughs and recording secretary, Pamela Hansen, were also present.
- Public was welcomed. The flag salute was recited.
- Report from Closed Session: No action was taken.
- Public Hearing: No one requested to address the Board.
