THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Governing Board hereby determines, as required by Education Code Section 60119, that the school district has sufficient instructional materials for each pupil in the following areas:

- 1. Mathematics
- 2. Science
- 3. History-Social Science
- 4. Reading/language arts, including the English language development component of an adopted program
- 5. Health

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board does provide public notice that the attached calculations and documentation of the Gann limits for the 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 fiscal years are made in accord with applicable constitutional and statutory law;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Board does hereby declare that the appropriations in the Budget for the 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 fiscal years do not exceed the limitations imposed by Proposition 4;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Superintendent provides copies of this resolution along with the appropriate attachments to interested citizens of this district.
