

#### **Honor Cords**

- 3.500 cumulative GPA over 7 Semesters or combination of Semesters/Quarters (running start)
- Students/Families will be notified of eligibility via email
- Reserve your honor cord via Pay Online portal by 4/17/24
- Cords ordered by 4/17/24 delivered with Cap & Gown
- After 4/24/24, cords available in-person only at the ASB Bookkeepers Office

- Microsoft Form going live at the end of this meeting
- Write-in the name of a classmate you would like to nominate to speak at Gradation
- Write-in the name of a staff member you would like to nominate to speak at Graduation
- The Student and Staff member that receives the most write-in votes will be asked to speak at Gradatuion

## Staff Selected Student Speaker



- 3.700 or higher cumulative GPA
- Email sent to qualifiers with application and submission instructions on 3/1/24
- Applications due by 3/27/24
- Applications reviewed by the Graduation Committee; 5 candidates are selected for interview
- Interviews will be held on 4/24/24
- Staff Selected Speaker will be notified by the end of the day on 4/26/24
- Speaker to give a 3 min speech during the graduation ceremony
- 100% voluntary qualifiers DO NOT need to apply

## Senior Awards Assembly




- Student Driven it is a celebration of their 4 years at Skyline

## Final Transcripts & Diploma Pick-Up



- Create an account at www.parchment.com
- Order your transcript to be sent to your college. Select "Hold For Grades"
- Transcripts on hold will be released as soon as grades are posted, seniors graduated and transcripts are final. Expected release date of 7/3/24
- Diplomas will be available for pick-up on 6/20/24 in the counseling office from 9AM to 2PM
- Running Start students enrolled in a Spring Quarter Class required for graduation can pick-up their diploma on 7/3/24 in the Counseling office from 9AM to 12PM
- ONLY STUDENTS AND PARENTS/GUARDIANS listed in Skyward can pick-up diplomas. If you cannot make these 2 dates, diplomas can be picked-up in the attendance office when school opens in August

### **Yearbook Quotes**

- \* 1 senior per 10min slot, but if you bring a friend, I can likely get them in as well 2/26/2024 4/5/2024, no exceptions.
- \* Must sign up for slots on SignUp Genius

  Remove yourself if your plans change and you're not able to make it
- \* Written quotes in any form will not be accepted; You must speak the entirety of your quote OUT LOUD if you want it in the book.
- \* Blakney will either approve your quote and check you off, or will deny your quote and provide an explanation why.

You can sign up for another slot and try again if your quote is denied.
