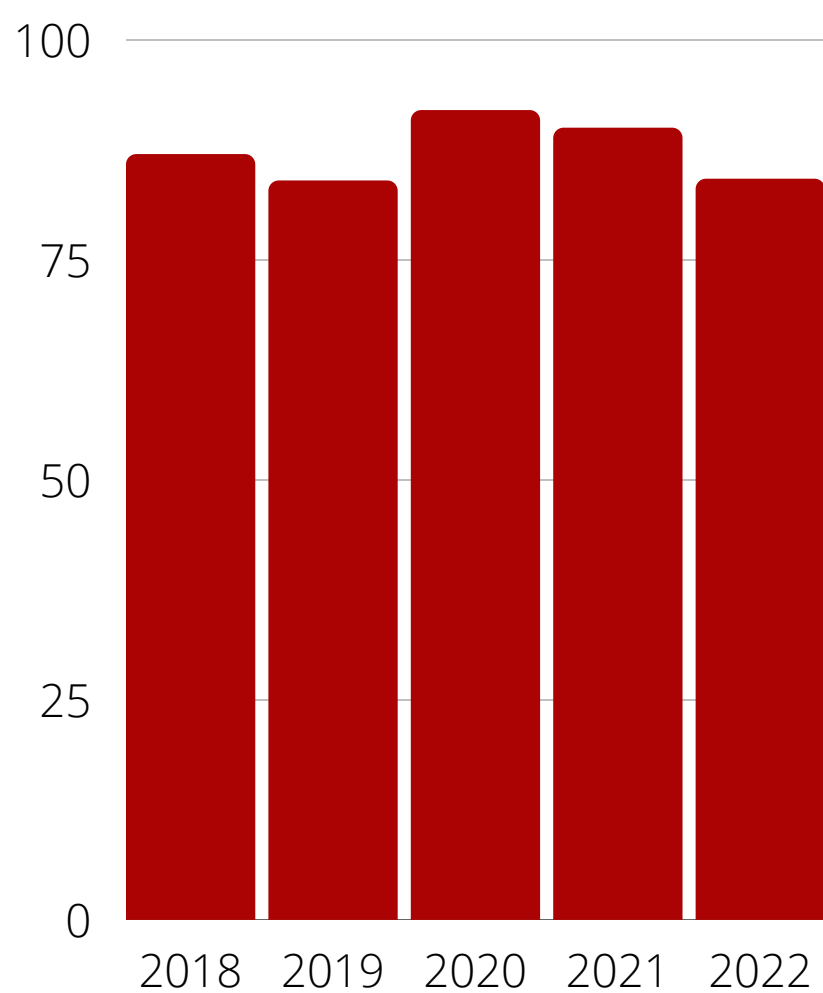

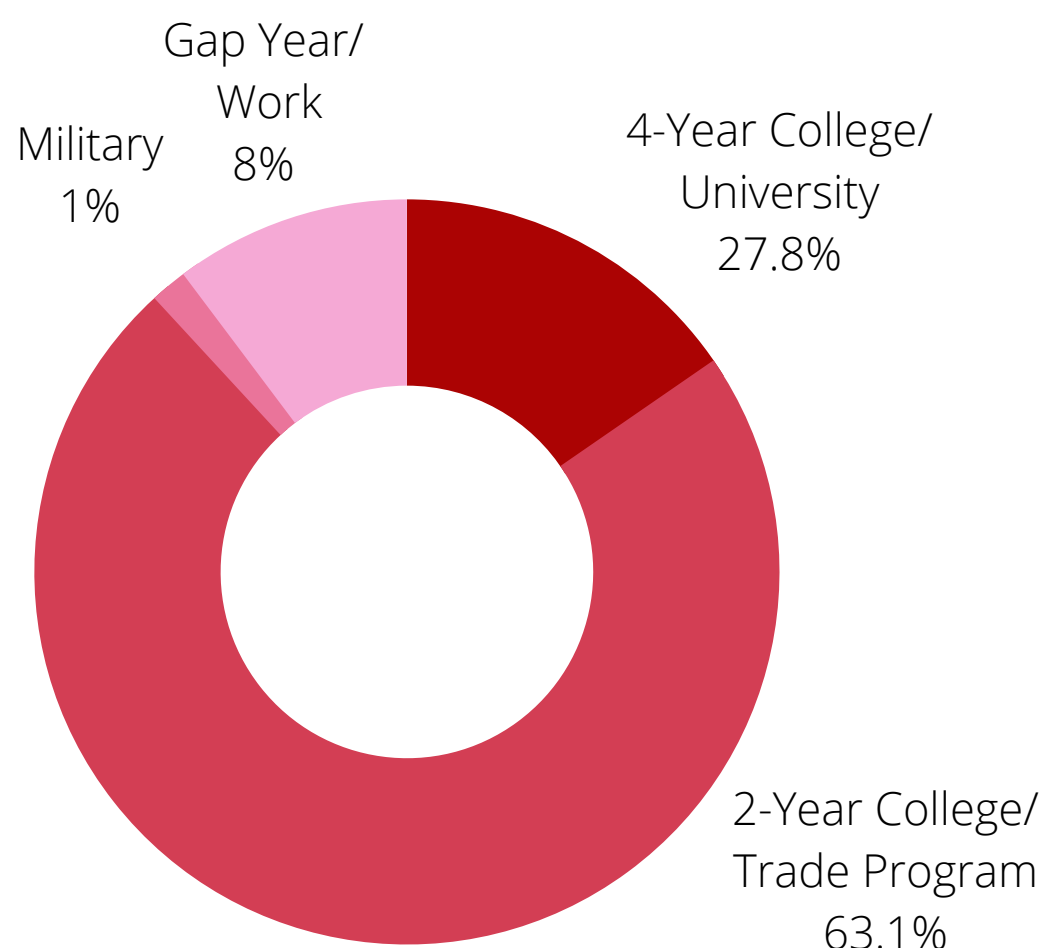
Grading & Transcripts

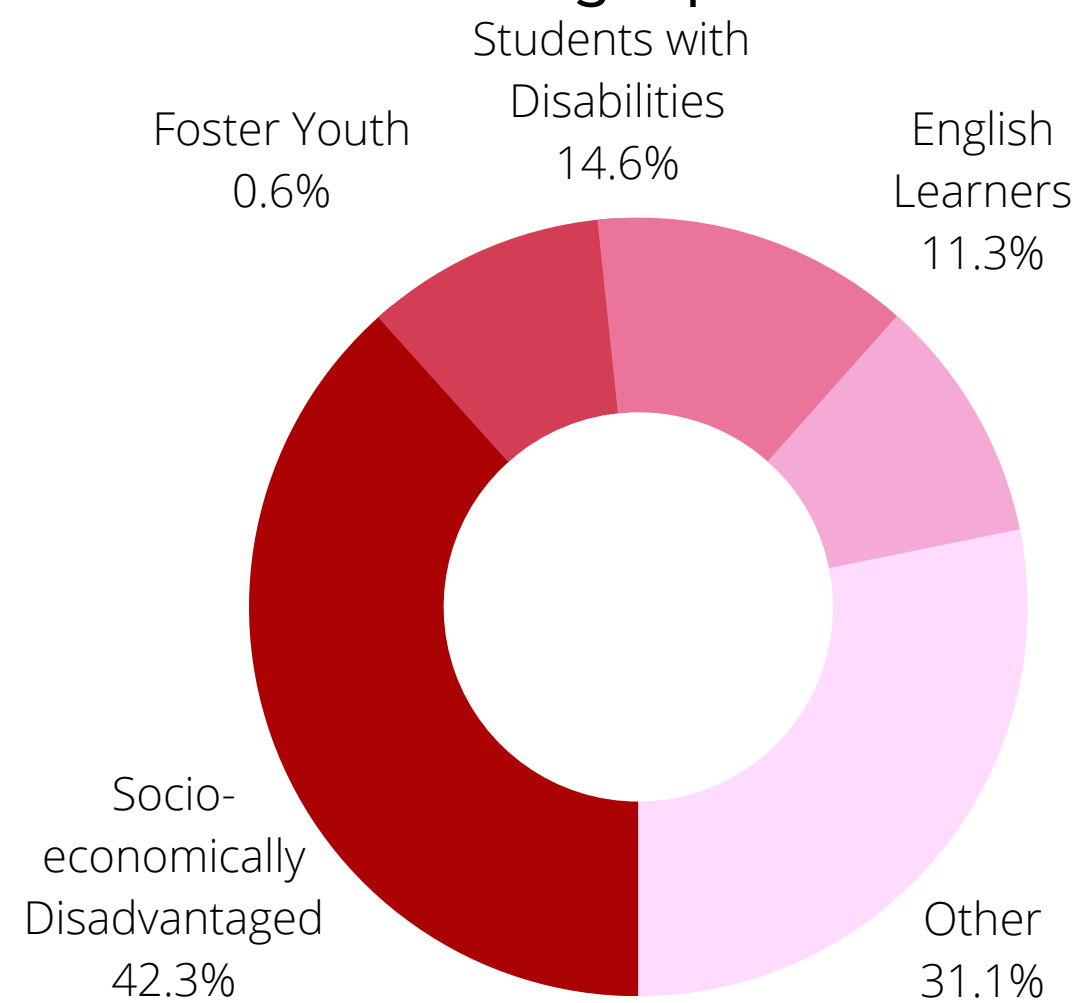
Advanced Placement Results

- 55% of the exams scored a 3 or higher.

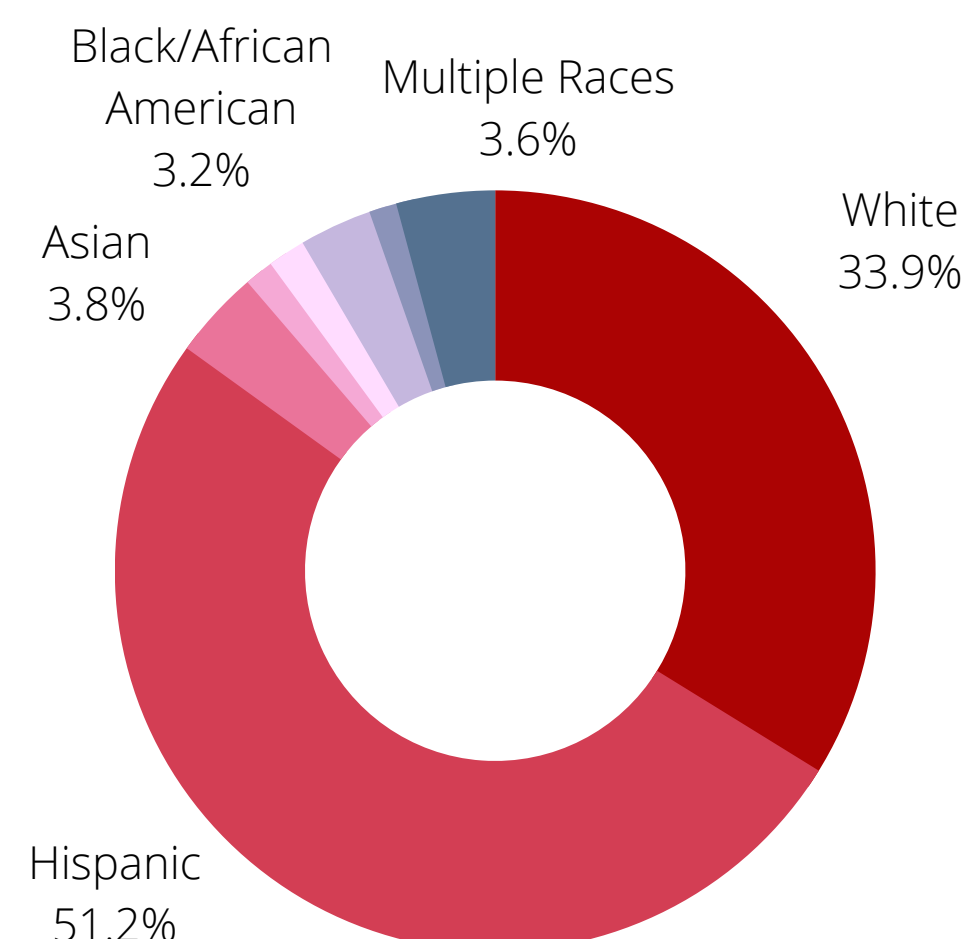
Post-Graduation Plans

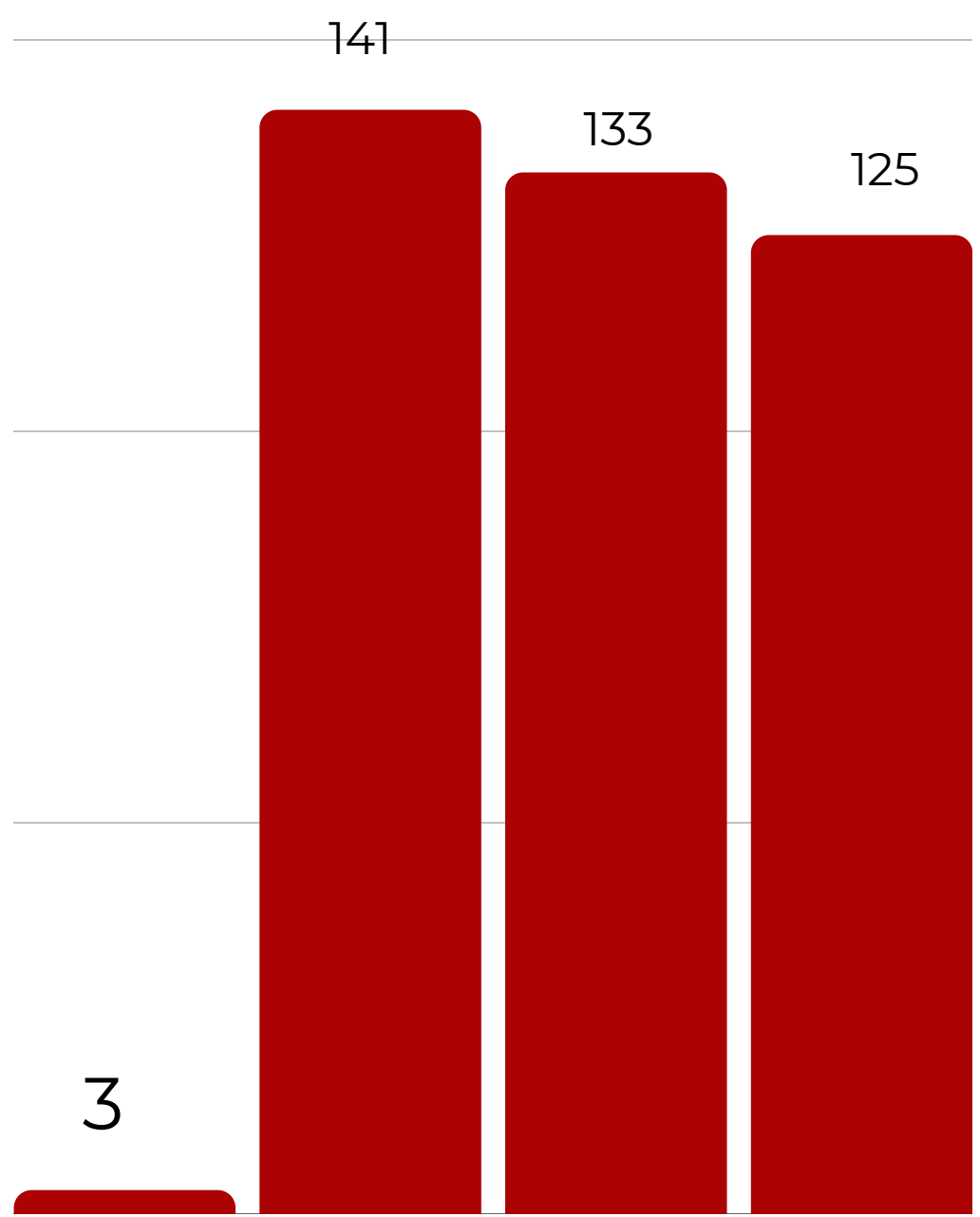
