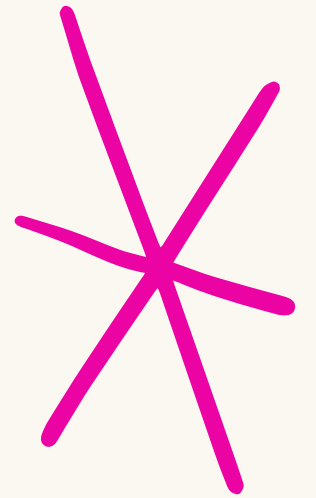
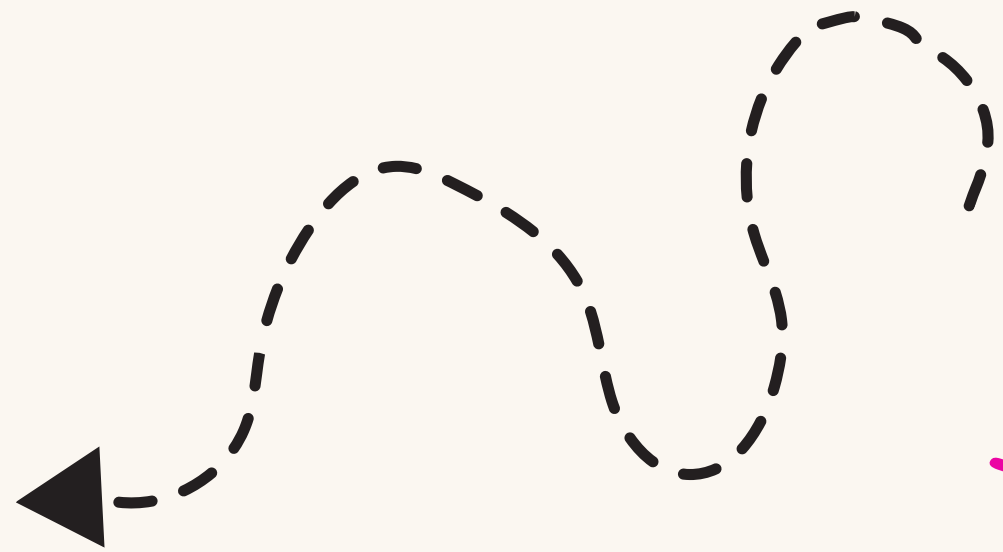

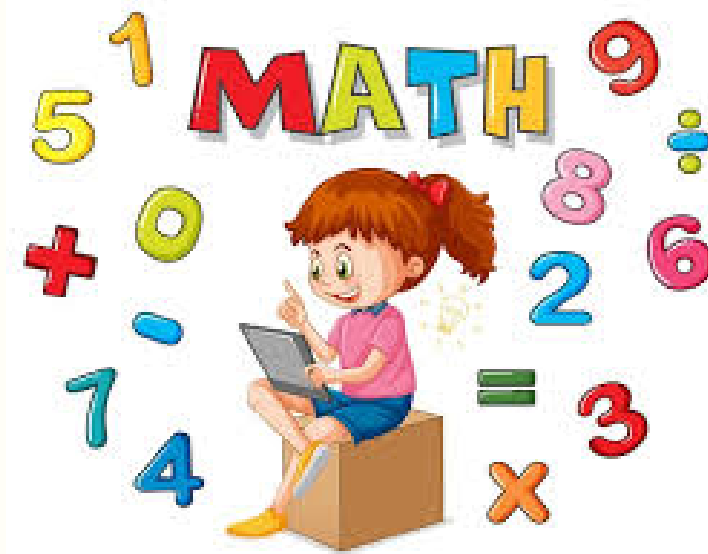

Mathematics, or math, is the study of numbers and how they are related to each other and to the real world.

EXAMPLE:

Adding $3 + 7 = 10$

Subtracting $10 - 4 = 6$

Multiplying $2 \times 4 = 8$

Dividing $6 / 2 = 3$

Balancing a checkbook, measuring out a recipe, and counting paper plates for a party are all examples of mathematics in daily life.

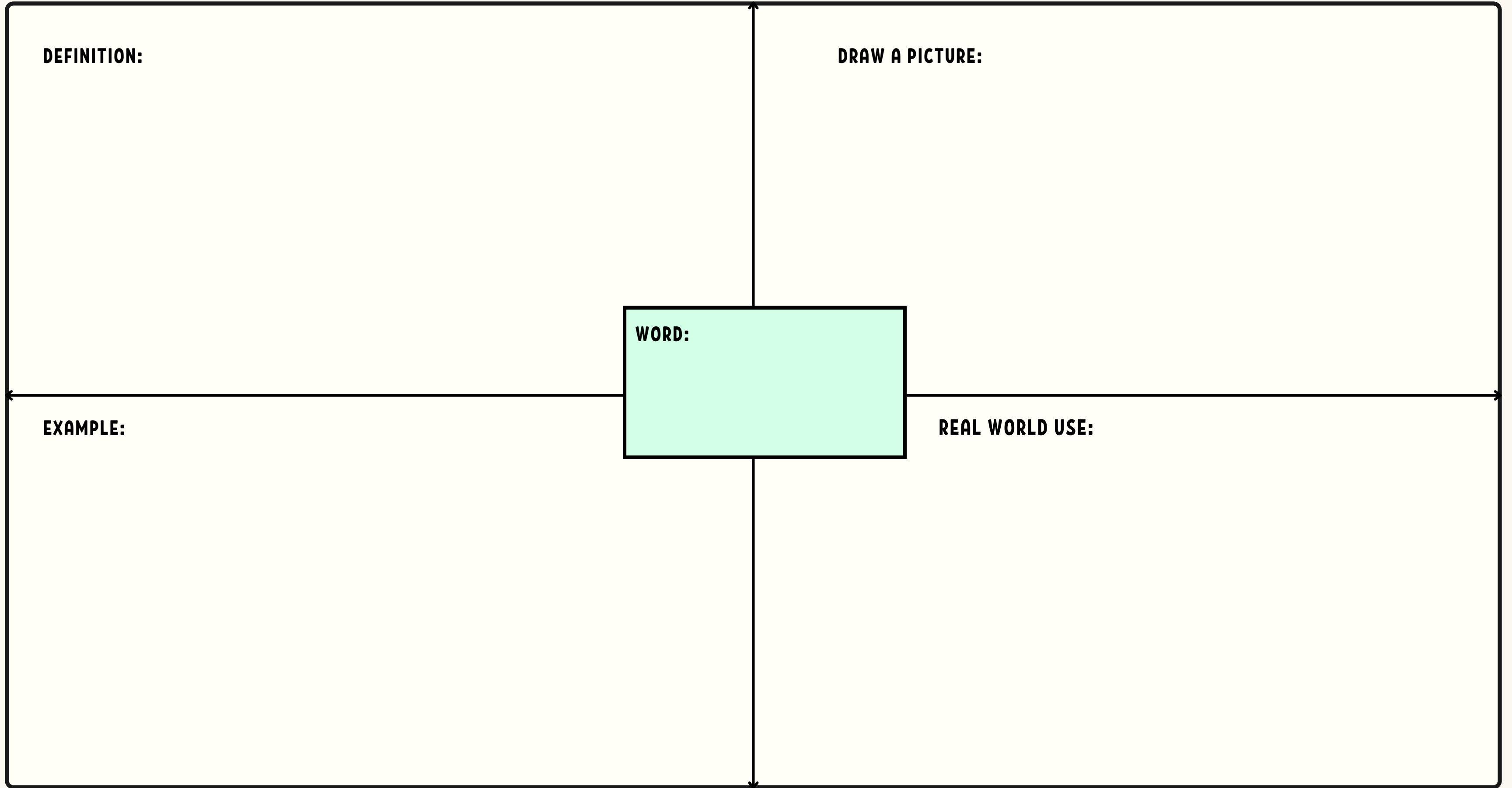



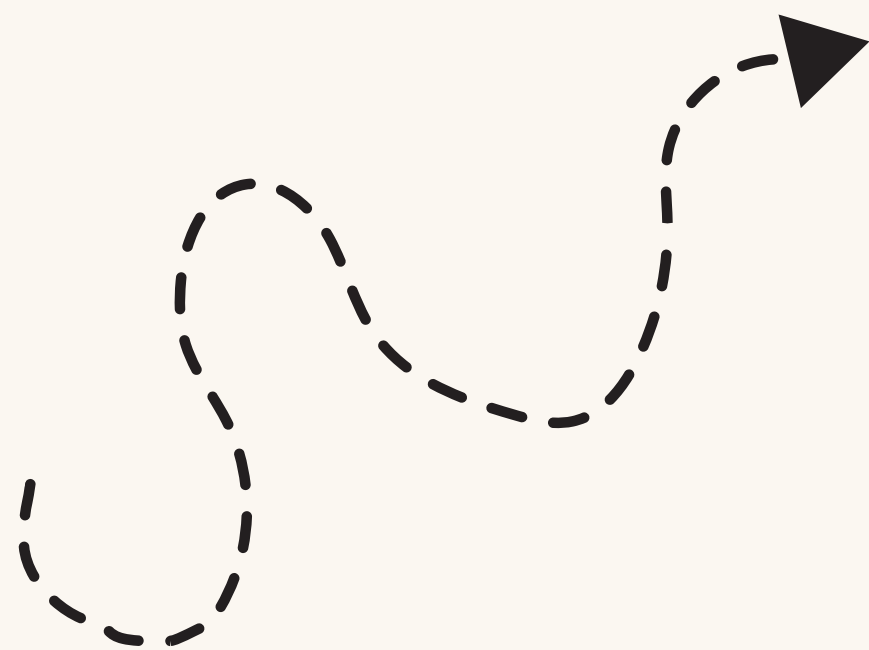
