

Toileting

The Fargo Public Schools will not refuse admission to students based on their ability or inability to use bathroom facilities independently and/or control bodily functions associated with toileting.

Students who exhibit repeated inability to use bathroom facilities independently and/or control bodily functions associated with toileting who do not already have a plan that addresses toileting needs should be referred to the building administrator to begin the process for determining the category of need (e.g., special education, medical, mental health, etc.).

Students having confirmed contagious disease which could be contracted by others through student's urine or feces may be excluded from school for a reasonable amount of time to allow for medical intervention and for the school to develop and implement a hygiene plan for both student and employees.

Administrators shall develop privacy, hygiene, and staff supervision requirements for students who have toileting needs.
