Code of Conduct and Refund Policy

Code of Conduct

The U of D Jesuit Summer Enrichment Experience program provides an environment that allows each student to participate and engage in class and activities that help them learn, grow, and have fun safely.

Students agree to these code of conduct guidelines:

- Students shall be responsible for their words and actions and will be respectful of other students, teachers, and staff members. Students are prohibited from engaging in any verbal or physically aggressive behaviors.
- Students will be respectful of their surroundings, equipment, and environment. Students are prohibited from engaging in theft of any sort or taking property that does not belong to them.
- Students will dress appropriately and arrive to class on time with all necessary materials.
- Students will not endanger the health and safety of themselves or others due to inappropriate physical contact or possession of prohibited substances (alcohol, illegal drugs and paraphernalia, or dangerous weapons.) Any student found to be in possession of such materials will be dismissed from the summer program immediately.
- Students are expected to follow the instructions of their teacher(s) without engaging in any distracting behaviors that can disrupt the learning environment.
- Students will always remain in their appropriate classroom unless given permission by their teacher to leave the classroom.

Minor violations of the code of conduct will be addressed by the teacher, staff member, or school administration. If the behavior persists, parents will be contacted. If, after a parent call, the behavior continues, the student will be dismissed from the program and no refund will be issued. Major violations of the code of conduct will result in a student's immediate dismissal.

Examples of major violations include, but are not limited to harassment of any kind, fighting, engaging in behavior that endangers others, theft, or destruction of school property. The Summer School Director will serve as the final arbiter of student behavior.

Refund Policy

No refunds will be issued unless an experience or a camp is not held due to low numbers. Students dismissed for code of conduct violations will also not be issued a refund.
