- High school equivalency (GED) classes/referrals

The youth MUST be goal oriented: will graduate from high school and either go into the military, the workforce or post-secondary education.

- Youth must be low income AND have a barrier to employment (IEP, 504 plan, runaway, foster care, pregnant or parenting, has a disability, on medication or being treated by a physician, in counseling, an offender or basic skills deficient in either Math or Reading.
- Those receiving free/reduced lunches are considered to be low income.
