Message from the Superintendent . . .

"It Takes a Village . . . "

The support that our community shows our school district is often noted and much appreciated. In the May edition of the "What's Happening," I asked you to come out and vote for our budget, capital project, and Board of Education members. You came out in record numbers and I want to thank you all for your support. All of our propositions passed by a wide margin and planning for the capital project is underway.

The capital project will help us to better serve our students with upgrades to the high school cafeteria and middle school home and careers room, along with upgrades to other instructional areas. The project will also include much needed updates to our pavement, bus loops, and driveways at all three facilities. The track will be resurfaced at the high school and new bleachers along with additional storage and a long sought-after press box will be added to the field. More detailed information regarding the scope of the project can be found on our webpage.

Approximately 84% of the cost for the capital project will be paid for through the State Education Department Building Aid. The remainder will be paid out of the district's capital reserve fund. There will be no tax impact or increase needed to support the project. Thank you again for your support in providing a first class education to the students in our district.
