Hello Leota families,

This will be Northshore School District's fifth year partnering with King County's Best Start for Kids Initiative to provide our students with a screening and intervention program for mental health and wellness. This program is called SBIRT (Screening, Brief Intervention, Referral To Services) and uses the Check Yourself Screener. This year, we will be screening our 7th grade students in their Health Fitness classes. This semester, screening will occur during the week of February 26th.
