Consensus of Table Discussions – November 9, 2022

1. What are your initial observations after reviewing the survey results? What do you agree with? What do you disagree with?

- ✓ Seems consistent and is true for many students;
- ✓ Renovate NC tunnel;
- ✓ Were the results of the survey between different and similar groups?
- ✓ Consistency of classroom, lockers, fields and class tech;
- ✓ Classroom and cafeteria need improvements;
- ✓ SC cafeteria is bad;
- ✓ The survey results are pretty general – which classrooms need updates? Which fields? Which locker rooms? Why are there still chalkboards? Promethean tables, 3-D labs, animation studios, desks;
- ✓ Results were difficult to read;
- ✓ Priorities are air conditioning, turf/fields and bleachers need repair. Furniture/technology needs improvement in classrooms;
- ✓ SC Cafeteria;
- ✓ Bathrooms at both SC and NC need upgrades;
- ✓ Improvements of general classrooms is important;
- ✓ Cafeteria at SC needs updated;
- ✓ AC is important;
- ✓ SC layout needs improving;
- ✓ Classroom improvements are necessary;
- ✓ Bathroom updates are important;
- ✓ General updates – furnishings, specific classrooms like Special ED – are important;
- ✓ Ergonomic design in classrooms (chairs in Science rooms) is important;
- ✓ AC – results don't line up - #1 on some diagrams & #3 on other – this impacts learning;
- ✓ Does someone come in and say “you need to improve it”?
- ✓ How much would it cost to redo all of it?
- ✓ Special Ed is this something that can be addressed as a larger LADSE community?
- ✓ Consistency & Validity of data was discussed. We don't know what the quality of the data is. Parent, student, teacher perspective – how do results differ among those groups;
- ✓ Deeper dive into each question. (i.e. bathrooms, locker rooms) is necessary;
- ✓ Please consider a referendum.

2. What themes and trends do you see in the data? What does the data tell us about our community's "wants" as it relates to future facilities projects?

- ✓ There seems to be consensus
- ✓ Can they brighten up the tunnel with some student art work?
- ✓ Can seniors put their hand prints on the tunnels wall as a senior perk?
- ✓ Can they pipe in WLTL in the tunnel?
- ✓ Add signage on both campuses to make navigation easier.
- ✓ Updates needed for cafeteria, AC and classrooms.
- ✓ It seems that the data and future projects are aligned for the most part.
- ✓ Looks like the school is proposing the right projects for the future.
- ✓ One of the things noticed by the group was no mention of sustainability, energy efficiency, renewable energy sources. That should be a consideration.
- ✓ Automatic/sensor lights, faucets, solar energy – capitalizing on any federal and state rebates.
- ✓ Communal spaces (modernization, furniture, whiteboards).
- ✓ Improvements of general classrooms.
- ✓ ADA inclusion.
- ✓ Athletic improvements.
- ✓ Flexible learning spaces.
