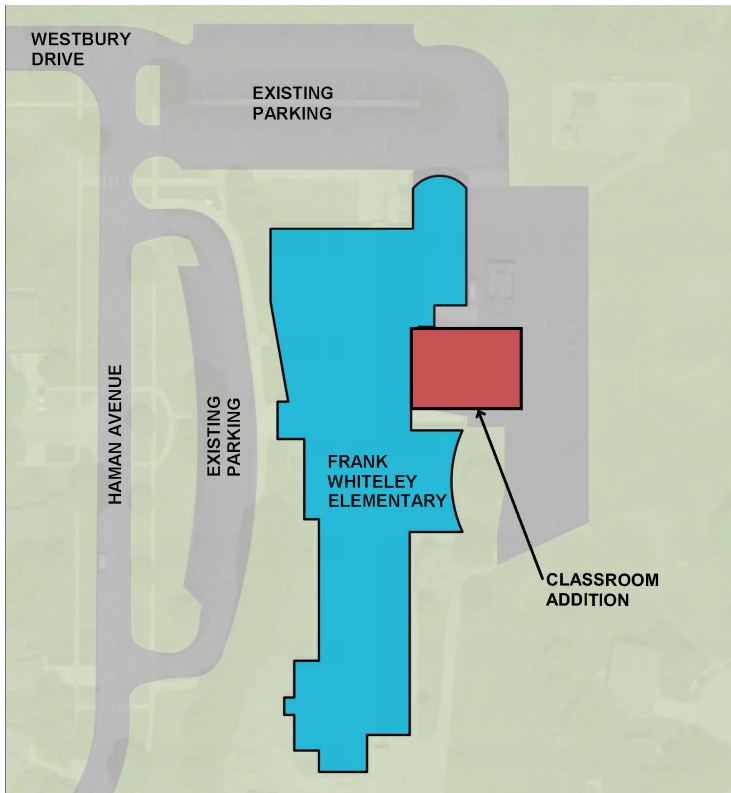

Updated Mechanicals & Infrastructure



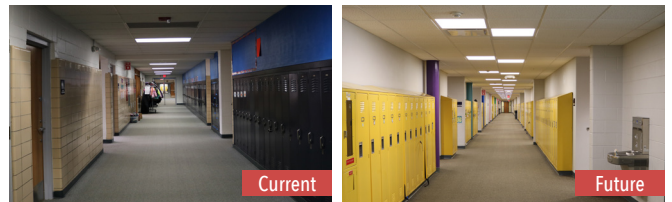
Roofing, plumbing, HVAC systems, and related upgrades will be addressed districtwide.

New Flooring, Ceilings & Related Improvements



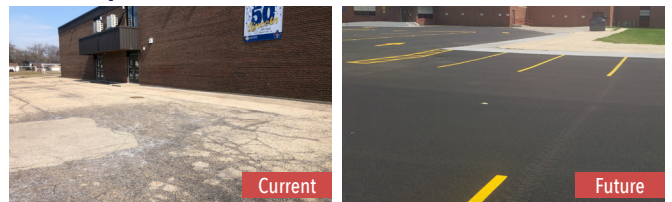
Learning space improvements include new flooring, ceilings, cabinets, furniture, and lockers.
