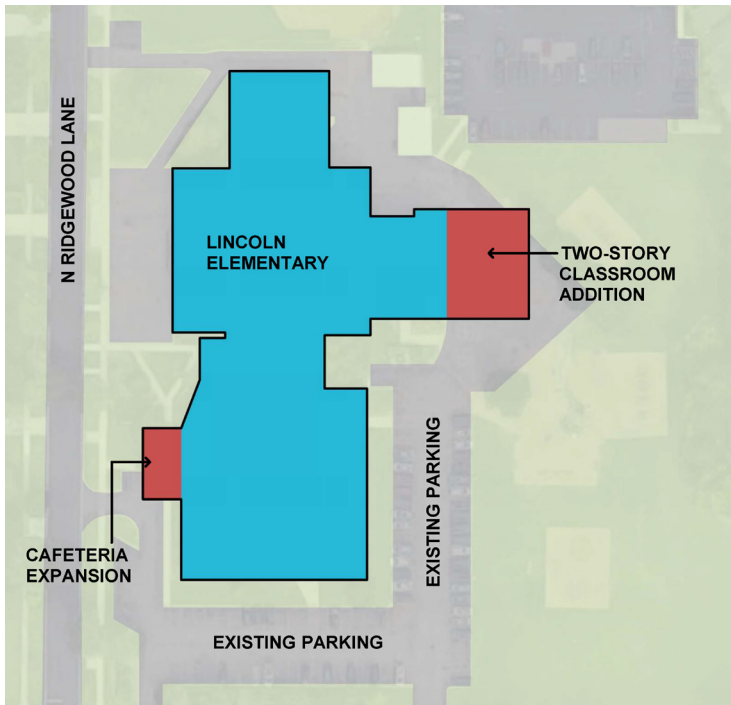
LINCOLN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

Updated Mechanicals & Infrastructure



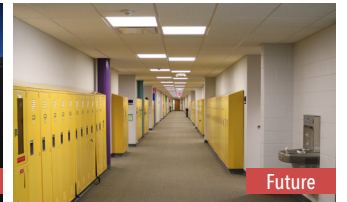
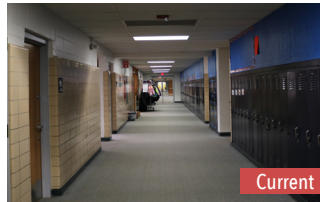
Roofing, plumbing, HVAC systems, and related upgrades will be addressed districtwide.
