- <u>Ten Monthly Payments</u> Ten equal monthly installments due June 2024 through March 2025 with an annual processing fee of \$55.00 to FACTS. For budgeting purposes, you may choose the 5th or the 20th of the month as the date your payments will be electronically withdrawn from your bank account.
