Purpose	The Facilities Committee exists to provide strategic oversight of the District's facilities activities and to support communication of these activities to the School Board and community at large. The committee discussions will provide an understanding of project priorities, funding, and goals that will enable committee Board members to give input to staff, communicate to the full School Board and make recommendations as appropriate.
Goals	<ul> <li>Provide an environment for extended research and discussion of issues that allows staff to vet ideas and suggestions before making final recommendations.</li> <li>Prioritize available resources and projects for recommendation to the Board</li> <li>Participate in consultant selection for major strategic projects</li> <li>Identify opportunities for lease income</li> <li>Ensure Board member awareness and understanding of project priorities, funding, and goals of the facilities programs.</li> <li>Coordinate with communications director on strategic level internal and external communications related to facilities</li> <li>Review and make recommendations about any agreements for use of PUSD facilities by outside agencies including 'joint use' and civic center permits</li> <li>Create a master schedule and work plan to guide Facilities Committee meeting agenda setting</li> <li>Review facilities master plan and develop recommended priority actions and timing</li> <li>Explore and develop funding options for capital investment in facilities</li> <li>Ensure linkages between facilities activities and other District programs and curriculum decisions</li> <li>and make appropriate recommendations and</li> </ul>
