LADD Updates

- Our department sent over 21 coaches, teachers, principals, and district TOSAs to an all day workshop on how to support and identify for eligibility English Learners with IEPs;
- LADD trained all schools on the VCCALPS testing of EL students with special needs;
 - VCCALPS is a separate instrument used to assess students with an IEP that might not otherwise be able to take any or all parts of the ELPAC;

LADD Updates

- We have officially ELPAC tested 2,440 English Learners this past spring, and 372 students met all requirements for reclassification giving us a final Reclassification percentage of 16%;
 - LADD has provided every reclassified EL with an individualized trophy and certificate signed by the superintendent;
- This year the PUSD will ELPAC test 2,196 English Learners; many schools have begun testing;

LADD Updates

- LADD funded for substitutes to assist schools that have many ELs with ELPAC testing; we trained, calendared, and arranged for the substitutes to go to the many schools with many ELs to help with testing;
- Our English Learner After-school and Saturday school tutoring and intervention is a BIG success, currently LADD is helping ELs at Altadena, Cleveland, Franklin, Hamilton, Jackson, Jefferson, Longfellow, Madison, McKinley, Roosevelt, Washington Elementary, Willard,
 Blair H.S., and PHS;



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
