Reclassification of English Learners

After-school and Saturday **Tutoring and** Intervention for English Learners

• We were able to hire and pay salaries and benefits for 37 certificated teachers to provide tutoring & intervention for over 400 EL/RFEP students at 11 school sites;

English Learner Professional Development and Strategy Workshops

Organized 10 off-site, all day, LACOE English Learner Workshops and trainings for principals, coaches, and secondary ELD teachers (LADD paid cost of all workshops, providing substitutes for all teachers, and reimbursement for their travel mileage and lunch);

Trainings, school support and Presentations

LADD presented at all district-wide professional development trainings, at the weekly coaches meetings, and organized an EL Literacy Committee with coaches from all the schools that met regularly and presented at meetings;

Newcomer EL students at The International Academy at Blair
