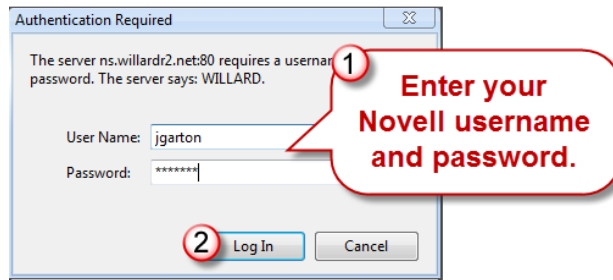
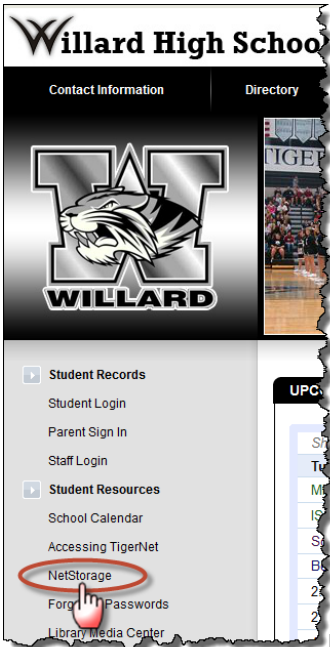


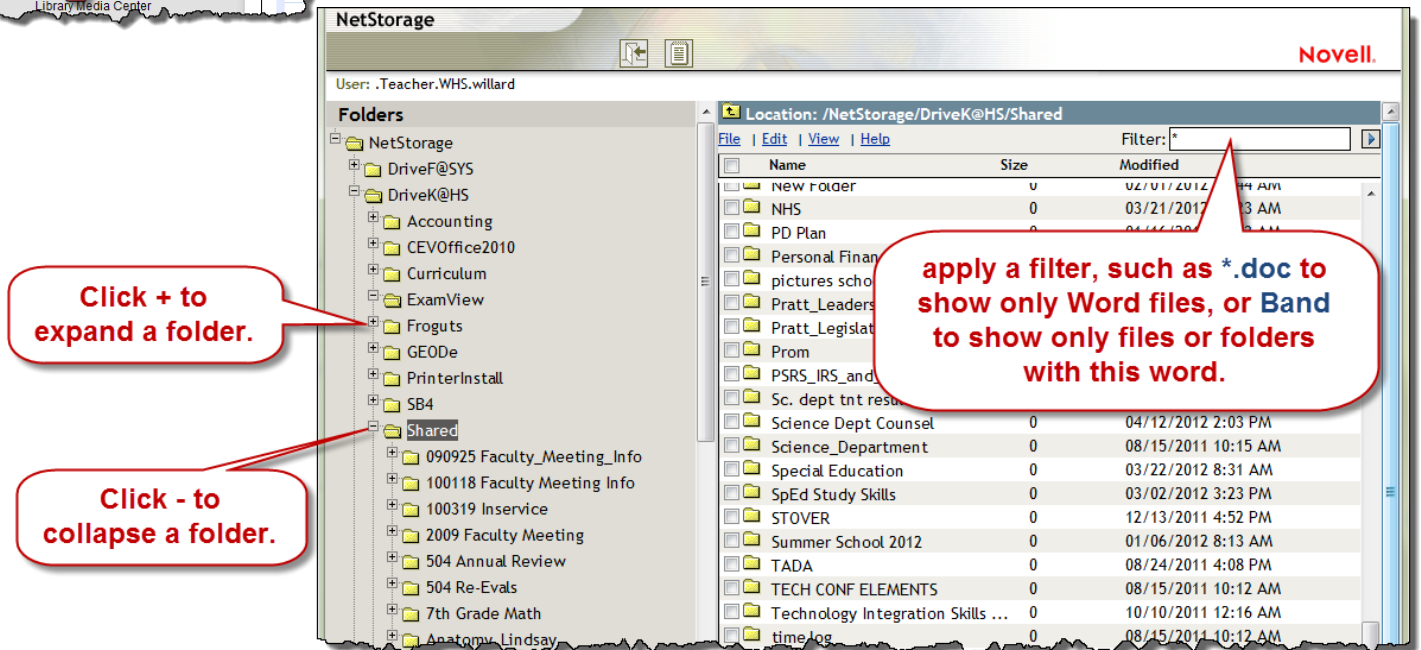
# NetStorage

NetStorage allows teachers and students to access files on the server from any Internet connected device, from any location, using a browser or app. You will have access to all the same folders and files that you do when logged in at school on a station. You can upload and download files, and manage your files and folders.

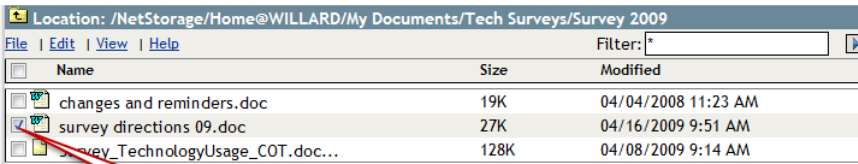

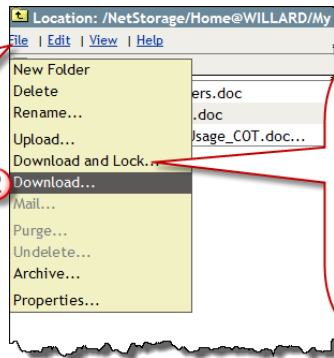


# Download a File



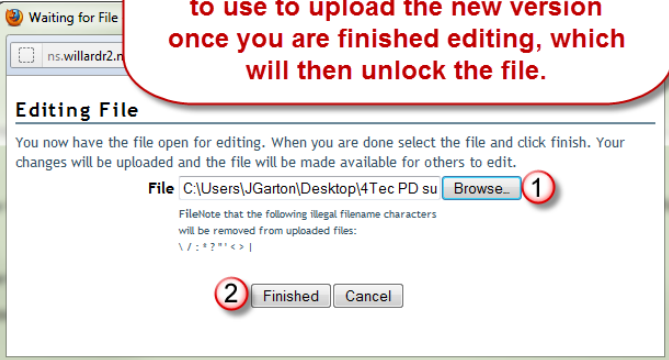
Check the box for the file you want to download.

1 Open the File menu.



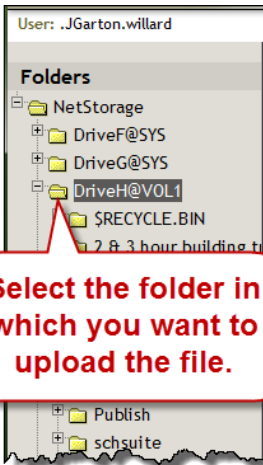
If this is a shared file, you can choose Download and Lock. This will lock the file on the server so that another person can't make changes to it while you are editing it.

If you choose Download and Lock, this windows will also open for you to use to upload the new version once you are finished editing, which will then unlock the file.



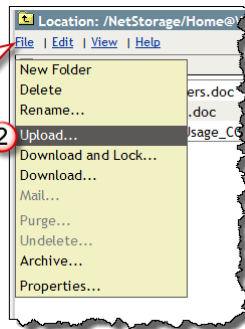
The file will download to the location you have set in your browser preferences (ie Desktop, Downloads folder). You can then open the file on your device using the appropriate software. If you make changes to the file, you can upload it to NetStorage.

# Upload a File

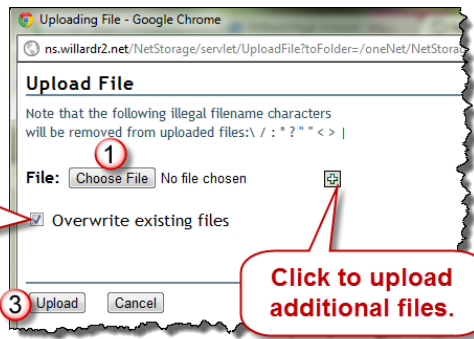


Select the folder in which you want to upload the file.

1 Open the File menu.



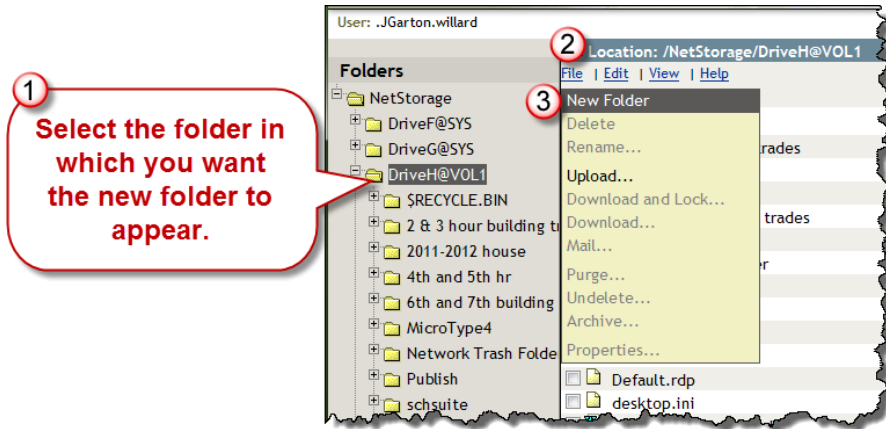
2 Check this box to replace the old file with the new one.



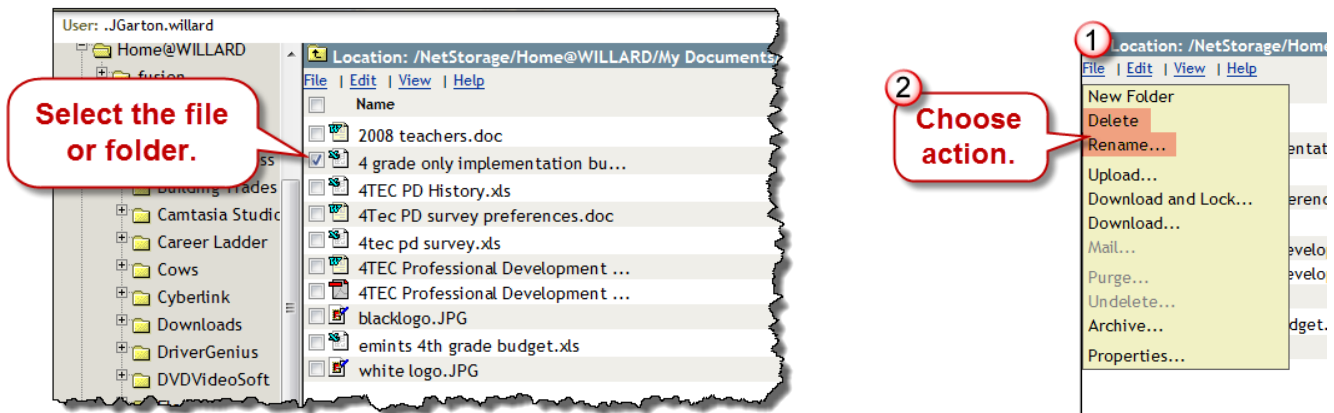

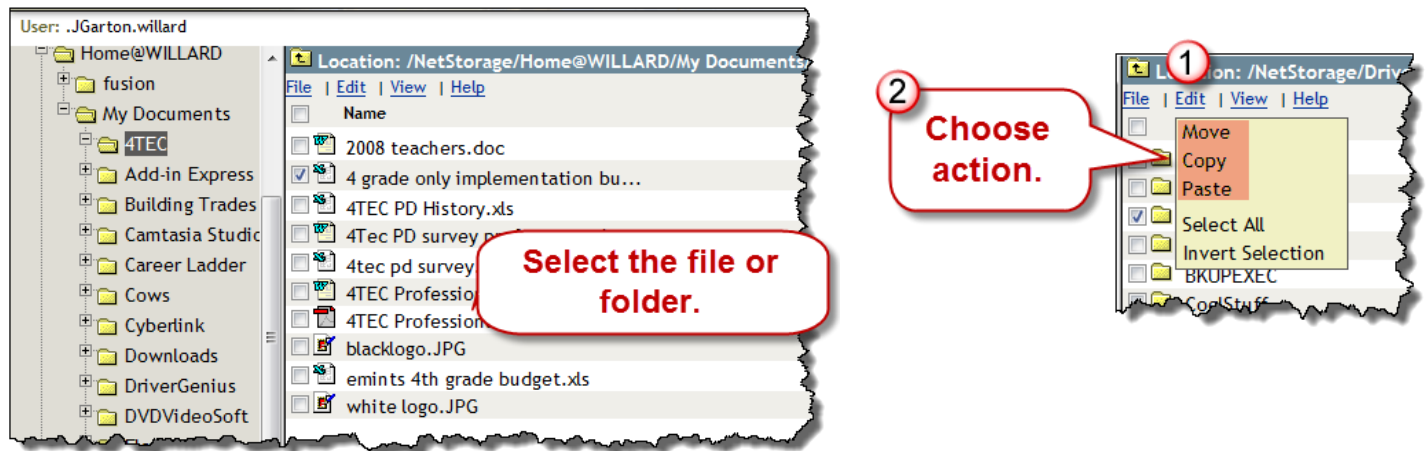

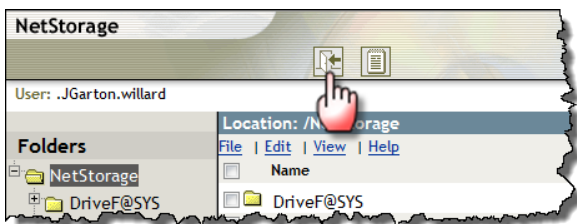

## Accessing NetStorage on a Tablet or Smart Phone

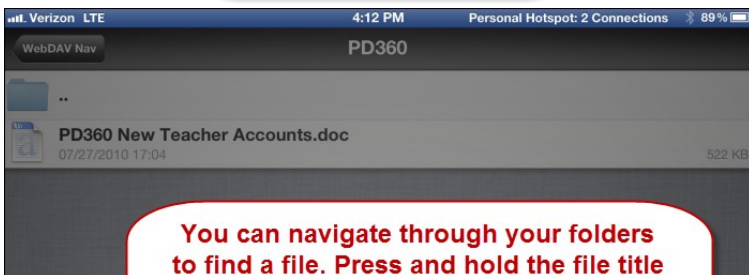
On an iPad, iPhone or Android device you can use a DAV client to access NetStorage. For both platforms you can use the app, [WebDAV Navigator](#). The screenshot below show the setup for an iPad or iPhone.

Once you've installed the app, click the + button in the top right corner to set up NetStorage as indicated below.

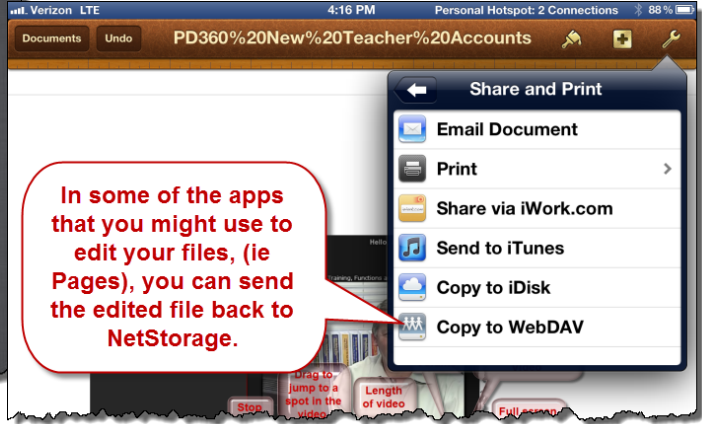


1 Enter the name of your choice.
