

### English and Reading

In English, Year 6 will continue reading *Treason* by Berlie Doherty. We will explore the world of Tudor England through the text and learn how to infer the feelings and motivations of characters and justify our answers with evidence.

We will continue to develop our skill as author by writing a range of narrative work linked to the text alongside non-fiction genres such as news reports and non-chronological reports.

### Maths

In Maths, we will be exploring algebraic reasoning and how this can be used to represent a range of mathematical concepts.

We will then move onto looking at how we can calculate using decimals and manipulate them using our place value knowledge.

We will continue to develop our arithmetic skills through weekly practise alongside developing our ability to reason mathematically.

### Design and Technology

In D&T, we will be using our scale models and designs of a green house to build and install a full size greenhouse into our garden.

We will be looking at how we can build sustainably and think carefully about the environmental impact of our new structure.

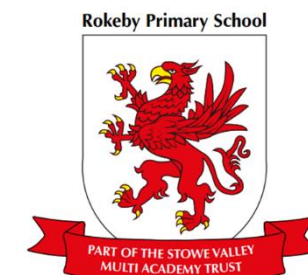
### History – The Tudors

We will be learning about the Tudors this half term. We will think about continuity and change across the dynasty and comparing the rule of different Tudor monarchs.

We will pose historical questions and follow a line of enquiry when we aim to determine whether Henry VIII can be considered a 'good' king.

We will compare life in Tudor England to life in England today and explore how things have changed, such as the role of women, and what has stayed the same, such as the monarch being head of the church.

## **Year 6 Curriculum Overview - Spring 2**



### Science – Animals including humans.

Year 6 will be learning how to classify organisms into groups. They will work scientifically by creating their own system of classification.

We will look at the biologist Carl Linnaeus and explore the system of classification that he created.

### Computing

Children will be supported in organising data into columns and rows to create their own data set. They will be taught the importance of formatting data to support calculations, while also being introduced to formulas and will begin to understand how they can be used to produce calculated data. They will use spreadsheets to plan an event and answer questions.

### French

In French, Year 6 will learn how to talk about themselves. They will be using their existing knowledge of vocabulary for colours, numbers, describing peoples appearance and hobbies.

### Religious Education (R.E)

In RE, Year 6 will be learning about how stories are used in the Hindu religion. We will be making links to other world religions that we have learnt about and thinking about how this applies to our lives.

### Physical Education

In PE the children will develop and apply their seated balance and floor work balance through focused skill development sessions, modified/non-traditional games and sports and healthy competition.
