### HEALTH SERVICES & SCHOOL (4K & 5K)

**FIRST AID:** Health services includes first aid as needed, usually provided by the Teacher or Secretary. For example if your child gets a cut or sliver the secretary would look at the injury, ask the child to wash the area and then apply a Band-Aid.

**ILLNESS:** If your child became ill the secretary would call you to pick up your child. This would happen if your child has diarrhea, has a fever over 100 degrees or has a communicable disease such as impetigo that cannot be covered. It is very important that you give us your contact information and several others we might contact if you are not available. Also let us know if that information changes during the year.

**SERIOUS INJURY:** If your child became gravely ill or were seriously injured the staff would call the ambulance. This could occur if your child had a seizure, an asthma attack, or some other serious health situation arose.

**MEDICATIONS:** If your child needs to take medications during the school day, you will need to complete a Medication Request form. You will need to provide the medication to the school in a properly labeled medication container. The school cannot give any medicine until you have the form completed and if it is a prescription, the physician has approved the request.

**IMMUNIZATIONS:** 4-year-old Kindergarten students must have 4 DPT, 3 Polio 3 Hepatitis B, 1 MMR and 1 Varicella (or have had chicken pox disease) before starting school or the parent may sign a waiver. Additional immunizations are required before the child enters 5K (4 DPT, 4 Polio 3 Hepatitis B, 2 MMR and 2 Varicella). Schools are required to send legal notices if timelines are not met. County clinics offer free vaccinations to children who do not have insurance or you may go to your doctor for the vaccines.

**PHYSICAL EXAMINATION:** It would be best to have your child have a physical examination before the end of June. This will allow sufficient time to follow up on any recommendations made by your doctor. Have the examiner complete the Physical Examination form and return the form to the school.

**DENTAL EXAMINATION:** A dental examination is recommended before school entrance. If your child has an exam scheduled in the next 6 months you do not need to make a special appointment, just take the form when you go in the next time. Have the dentist complete the form and return it to the school.

**EYE EXAMINATION:** An eye examination is recommended before school entrance. Wisconsin law requires schools request each student entering kindergarten for the first time (either 4K or 5K) have a professional eye exam. Many eye doctors provide a reduced fee for pre-kindergarten vision exams. Have the examiner complete the Eye Examination form and return it to the school.
