

## Applying for College

- 1) Go to the college website
  - Admissions Link
  - Undergraduate Admissions
  - Incoming Freshman
- 2) After you have applied go to the AHS counseling webpage  
<https://sites.google.com/site/annapolisguidance/home>
  - Look for the **docufide** link at the bottom of the home page
  - Create an account via **parchment.com**
  - For colleges in Michigan you will select where your transcript and ACT/SAT scores are to be sent
  - For colleges not in Michigan, email your counselor where you have applied and your transcript will be sent via the counseling office.
- 3) Fee Waivers – if you receive free or reduced lunch you are eligible for a fee waiver request.
  - Please check each college webpage on the method they want the waiver submitted (some have a form you are to fill out and submit to your counselor, some want an email, etc.)
  - Submit the fee waiver request to your counselor

Most colleges have a Dec. 1 deadline for scholarships, some may be earlier. If you apply for admittance after this date you are not eligible for these scholarships.

How do I pay for all of this??

- Search for independent scholarships (GCHS counseling department sends out scholarship information to senior students)
- Apply for Financial Aid (FAFSA) after October 1 but before March 1 (many schools suggest Feb 15 as the deadline)
