The Board of Education may, from time to time, establish committees whose membership will consist of members of the Board. The president of the Board shall serve as an ex-officio member of all committees to which he/she is not appointed. Board committees shall undertake studies and make reports as charged by the Board, but shall not act on behalf of the Board.

The Board may establish standing or ad hoc committees and reserves the right to terminate any committees at any time. One or more committees shall be appointed to visit every school building at least once annually, and report on the condition at the next regular Board meeting.

Any official policy-level action shall be in the sole discretion of the Board. The Board is in no way obligated to follow committee recommendations. The Board has the right to accept, reject, or modify all or any part of a committee recommendation.

All committees and/or sub-committees of the Board must abide by the provision of the Open Meetings Law and the Freedom of Information Law. Such committees must meet publicly, go into executive session only on a motion and only for one of the permitted topics, give advance notice of meetings, make public minutes and otherwise comply with all requirements of the Open Meetings Law and the Freedom of Information Law.
