5152	Admission of Non-Resident Students	

The Board of Education affirms that its primary responsibility is to provide the best possible educational opportunities for the children who are legal district residents and who are of legal age to attend school.

However, a non-resident student may not be admitted to district schools for any reason except if a former or future resident, as outlined herein.

The tuition charges for non-resident students shall consist of the cost as computed according to Part 174 of the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education.

Future Residents

The children of families who have signed a contract to buy or build a residence in the school district may be enrolled during the semester in which they expect to become residents, without payment of tuition.

Former Residents

The children of families who move out of the district before the end of the school year may be permitted to continue in attendance at the district until the end of the school year without payment of tuition, as long as the student meets the criteria of:

1. 12th grade students can complete their last year as a former resident.
2. Pre-K – 11th grade students can complete their last three months of the year as a former student.
3. All former students will retain the privilege if they remain discipline free. Any act that creates discipline from a detention or greater, will

immediately require the Principal to rescind the privilege of being educated in Central Islip School District.

However, students who are no longer district residents due to homelessness are addressed in Policy 5151, Homeless Children.

Transportation

Transportation will be provided for non-resident students if and only if existing bus routing is used, and there is sufficient room on the bus. The district shall not extend its bus routes outside of the district to pick up non-resident students.
