7500	Naming School Facilities	

To preserve the integrity of all, this honor must be reserved for individuals or with a recognized accomplishment and/or of good character. Thus, no Property or Program may bear the name of an individual convicted of a felony.

In general, Property or Programs should not be named for active employees.

With respect to the naming of Property or Program, special consideration shall be given to:

- The historical significance of the contribution of the individual or group to the institution;
- The association of the individual or group with the Property or Programs to be named;
- Any financial contribution of the individual or group to the Central Islip School District, Foundations and/or Central Islip-related student scholarship programs.
- State, regional, national, or international recognition of the individual's or group's contributions and achievements.
- A given surname may be assigned to only one Property or Program within the jurisdiction of the Board of Education.
- In all cases, naming rights are considered to be in effect for the duration of the effective and typical useful life of the Property or Program and not in perpetuity.
- If necessary, the Board reserves the right to remove a name associated with any Property or Program at any time if a gift pledge remains unfulfilled or a person no longer meets the criteria.

The Superintendent of Schools or the designee will develop a regulation to define the process.
