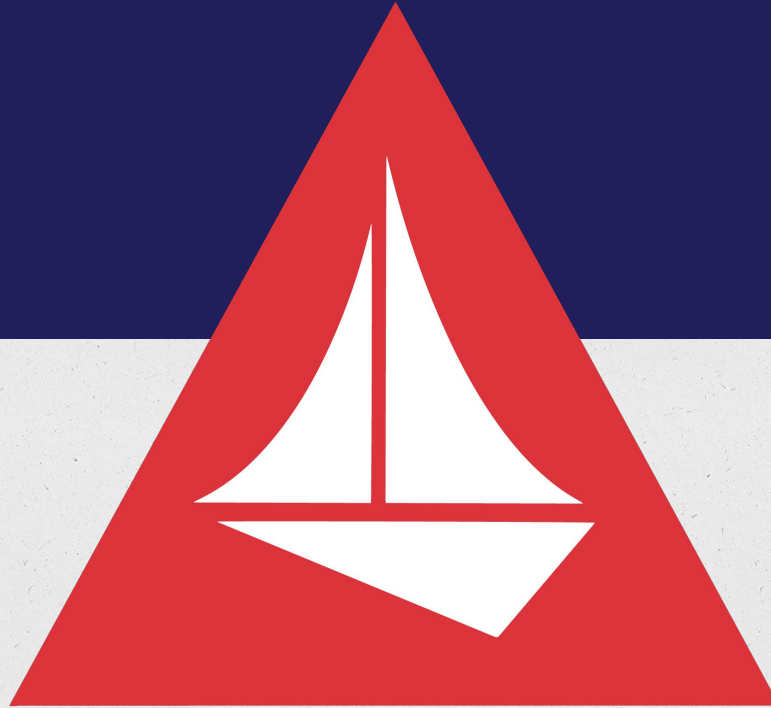

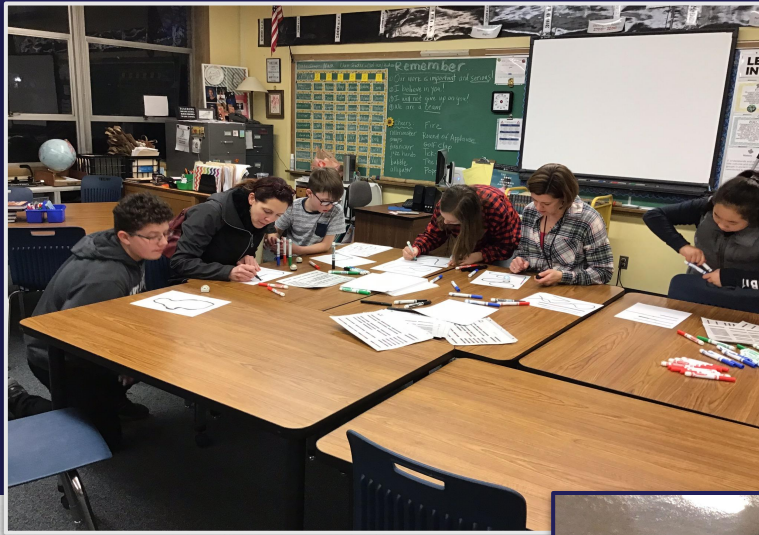




Current Building

I would prefer if the new school has a designated area where students can learn outside, which consists of lots of plants, that connect us to nature.

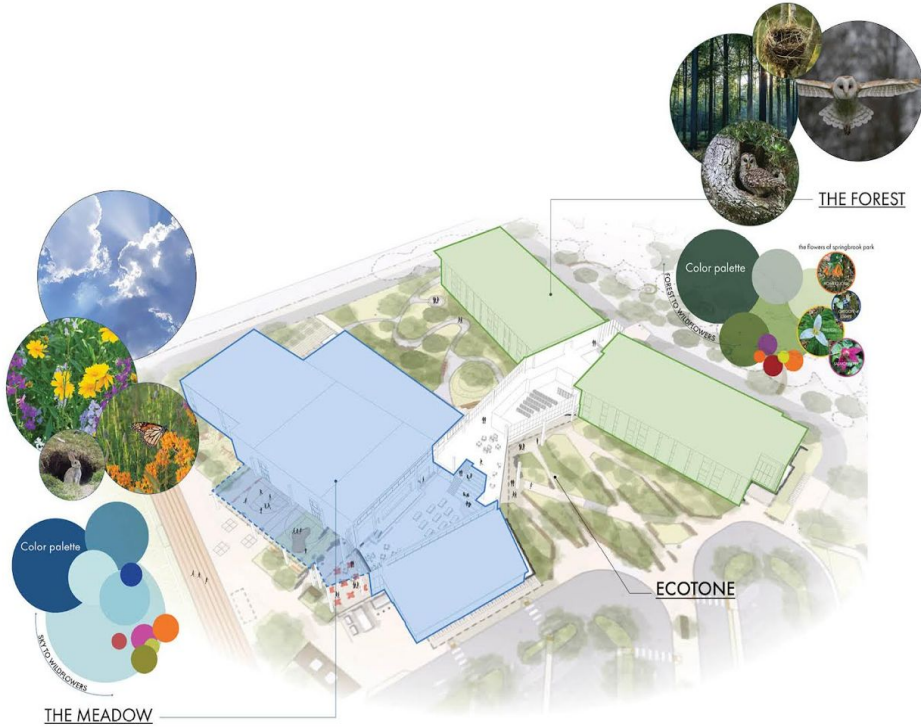
Lots of outdoor seating or benches for students to relax on before & after school

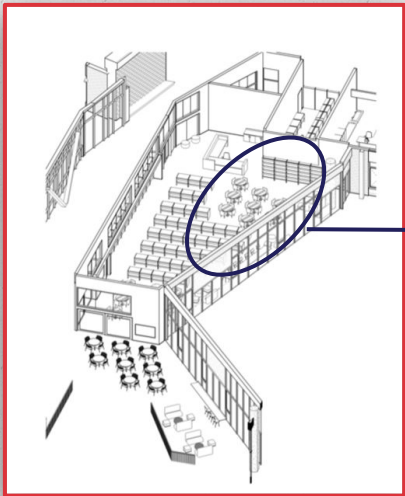
