• PE

- Teaches skills for sports
- Endurance, speed, and agility based workouts
- Weight Room workouts

PE Waiver

Completed Application Due by: June 7, 2024

Physical Education Waivers may be requested to waive PE during 6th, 7th, and 8th grade if students are involved in an approved private or commercially sponsored physical activity program that leads to Olympic-level competition.

These programs typically involve a minimum of 15 hours per week of highly intense, professionally supervised training. Sixth graders requesting OCPE <u>must pass a health exam</u> for acceleration (given in district) to be eligible for participation. More information can be found on the LT <u>OCPE webpage</u>.


High School Credit in Middle School

- HS credit course general guidelines
 - High School Credit awarded if final grade is 70 or above
 - High School courses taken in middle school are not calculated into High School GPA

- All other Technology classes have a prerequisite of passing Technology Applications.

Fine Arts


All 6th graders must choose 1 Fine Art Elective. You may choose 2 Fine Arts Electives, but 1 of them must be a Music class.

• 5th grade students attended the Fine Arts Showcase at HBMS on February 2nd.



Explanation of 6th Grade Pre-Athletics

This is a class designed for male and female students who have played competitive team or individual sports, or are wanting to participate in athletics at the middle school level starting in 7th grade.

Overview: The purpose of 6th Grade Pre-Athletics is to prepare students for the expectations of 7th Grade Athletics and the fundamental skills for sports offered in LTISD Athletics.

The 4 focus areas of this course are:

- 1. Role of a Student Athlete (academics, teamwork, character, competitor)
- 2. Fundamentals of Lifting Weights
- 3. Speed, Agility, Balance, Stamina, Flexibility
- 4. Sport-specific movements, fundamentals, and schemes

Students participating in Pre-Athletics must recognize that the workouts will build up to, and then be comparable to the workouts we give to our 7th and 8th grade student-athletes. The physical demands are greater than Physical Education, and the expectation is to give your best every day. Coaches expect students to work hard, have a positive attitude, and have fun.



Course Registration Instructions

• Log into LT1 Classlink

- Sign into <u>Skyward</u> with your <u>**student**</u> username and password.
- Click the **Course Requests tile** for the 2024-2025 academic school year.
- Under the Available Courses for 2024-2025 heading, search for each course using the course name or course number (use the course request form to find specific names and numbers), click the green circle with the + sign. This will move the chosen course to the right side of your screen. The course request appears under the Courses heading on the Requests tab. Repeat until you've requested all courses. You should have 7 courses requested.
- Now select the Alternate tab and add alternates to your Course Requests in case there are scheduling conflicts with your requested courses or course doesn't make. **Remember to place**

them in the order of 1st choice, 2nd choice, 3rd choice, etc.

- IMPORTANT: Your choices are not saved until you complete the step below.
- After you have finished selecting courses, <u>click Submit Course Requests</u> near the top left of the screen to save your requests. *If you don't submit, you will lose your courses that you selected.*
- Courses MUST be entered in by March 1, 2024!

Schedule Changes

- Schedule changes will be considered only in the event of inappropriate placement, movement between regular and Honors classes, lack of prerequisites, an error in enrollment or a scheduling conflict
- Since there are no single-semester courses in middle school, no mid-year schedule changes will be approved.
- Any schedule change must be requested through the counselor and ultimately approved by the Principal.
- <u>Requests for elective changes will not be honored</u> so please be thoughtful in ranking your electives choices.
