Ticketing

When & Where Can I Purchase Tickets?

- <u>BCMS tickets</u> are available online via the district athletic website through Etix. Any questions regarding issues while purchasing your ticket online, please contact Etix Customer Service at 1-800-514-3849.
- Cash ticket purchases are available in the Cavalier Activity Center (CAC), Monday through Friday during regular office hours. Ticket sales will end at noon on Fridays.
- Tickets will go on sale each game week at 8 AM. All tickets are single game tickets. Spectators should leave the stadium at the conclusion of their child's game. Spectators should not stay for the following games.

Who Can Purchase Tickets?

- Each player on the HOME TEAM roster has access to three (3) tickets.
- Each Auxiliary Group (Cheer/ Dance) has access to three (3) tickets.
- Each player on the VISITOR TEAM roster has access to two (2) tickets. Visiting team head coaches will provide their parents with a passcode to purchase tickets.

Seating

- HOME side seating will be available for <u>all</u> spectators. BCMS stadium does not have separate visitor side bleachers.
- Due to social distancing requirements, seats are available in groups of three (3), in the pattern
 of three seats open, two seats closed. <u>Some seating areas of the stadium are available in sets
 of two, rather than three. If your group is smaller than three, please sit in seats designed for
 parties of two or less.
 </u>
- Yellow tape will span across alternating rows to designate the row is unavailable.
- Yellow "X" stickers will designate individual seats that are unavailable.

General Information

- Gates open 15 minutes prior to the start of the first contest.
- Visitors and students 10 years of age or older must wear **a cloth face covering** upon entry to an area where UIL activities are being conducted.
- Designated Entrances and Exits are marked at the stadium main gate. There is one designated entrance line and one designated exit (shown on the map below).
- Concessions are NOT available at sub-varsity games. As a result, spectators may bring a
 water bottle into a sub-varsity event. <u>Drink containers, cups, and jugs are not allowed. This
 includes YETI style tumblers and restaurant cups.</u>

Team Info

Football

- Locker rooms will not be available for use.
- "On Deck" teams must sit in the end zones or on the practice fields. Teams that have finished their competition must sit in the end zones or practice fields. Due to social distancing, players may not sit in the bleachers.


Cheer / Dance

• Participants must cheer or dance from the track or field area. Due to social distancing, cheerleaders / dancers may not sit in the bleachers.


All Participants

- Spectators may not gather/mingle on the field at any time.
- All participants and spectators must leave the venue as soon as the competition is finished.
- Parents waiting to pick up their student from the game or event must wait in their car or outside of the facility and continue to maintain six feet of distance from other groups.

Seating



- Seats are grouped in sets of three (3)
- Seat configuration is 3 seats open, 2 seats closed. Every other row is closed entirely.
- Yellow tape and Stickers designate closed rows and unavailable seats.
