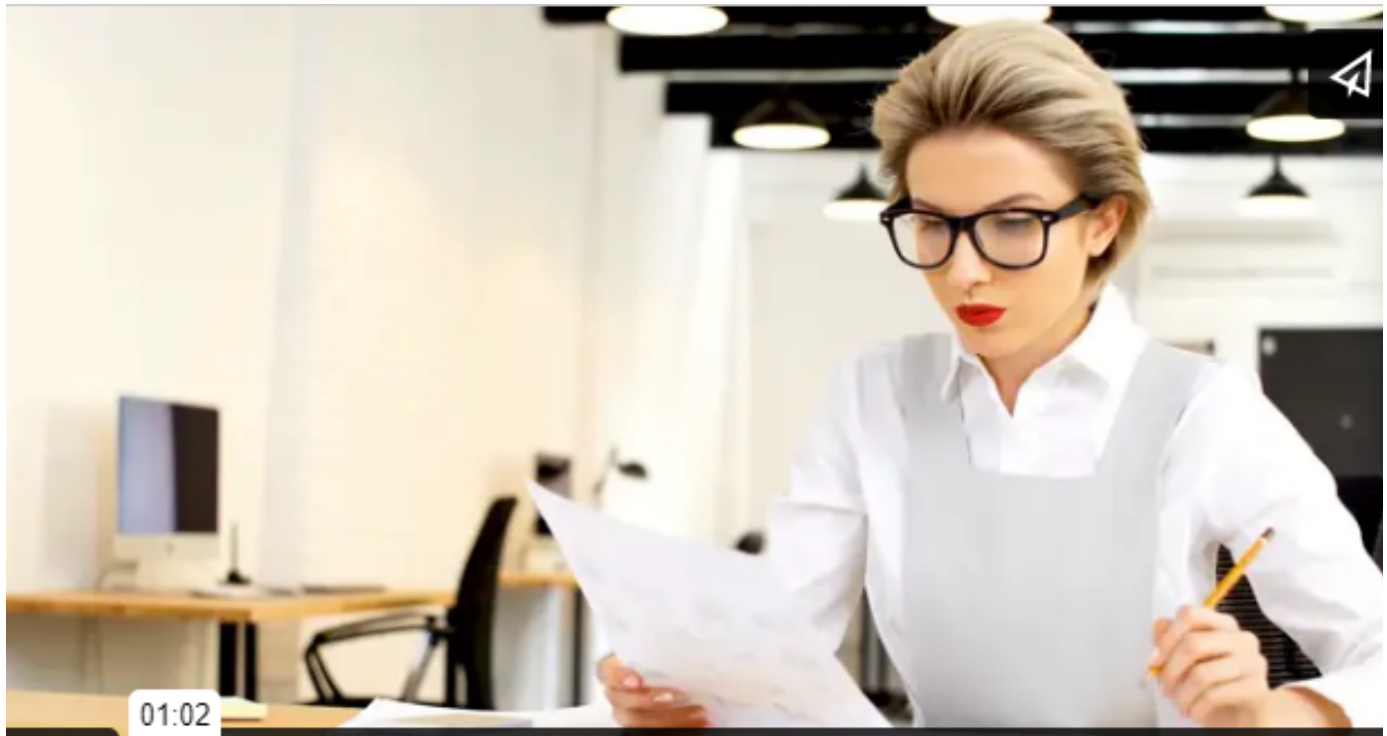

A Registration Packet must be completed and on file for any student attending the after-school program. Payment is due on or before the first of each month of service. Payment is required to be made via My School Bucks using the appropriate grade level tuition payment product and selecting the correct month from the drop-down list. RESERVED product listings are used for capped campus sites. Contact your child's respective campus to ensure availability.

TIME TO FILE YOUR 2022 TAXES



You may access any tuition paid during the January 1 - December 31, 2022, tax reporting period, via your My School Bucks account under your payment history.
