## JUDSON ISD ADVENTURE CLUB AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM



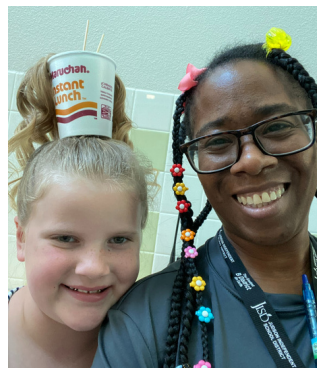

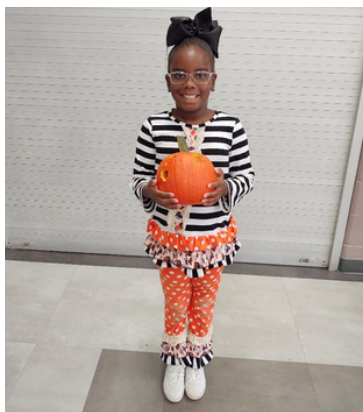

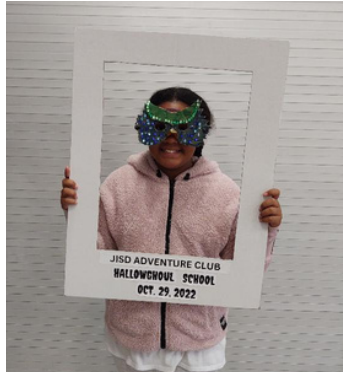
## ADVENTURE CLUB CAMPS

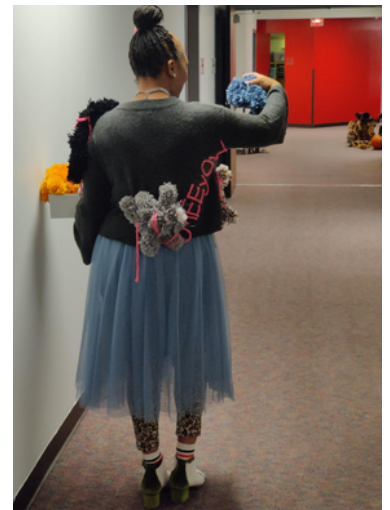
