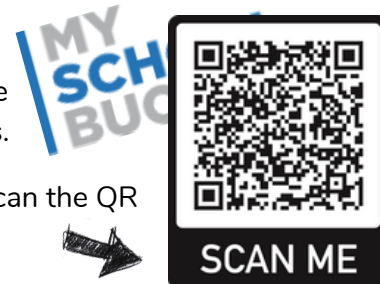
UKRAINIAN EGG-DYEING 3-PART ONLINE WORKSHOP

Registration for the 2022-2023 Judson ISD Adventure Club After School Program has finally recovered from a very rocky start. The online registration and payment via the My School Bucks website is now working. However, parents who are still experiencing issues, may contact their child's campus for assistance. You may visit <https://www.judsonisd.org/Page/31092> for details on how to sign your child up.

Be advised tuition is due one month in advance, at the time of registration. Monthly tuition must be submitted via My School Bucks using the 22-23 products created for each campus respectively. Invoices are only being used for Late Pick-Ups. Student accounts with outstanding balances, from after school services, must be paid in full in order for the student to be admitted or remain in the program. Spaces are still available at most participating sites. Contact your child's campus Supervisor for information prior to submitting the online Registration Packet and Tuition Payment.

The Adventure Club After School Program will strive to provide age-appropriate, for all levels of PK-5th grade, enrichment activities while enhancing self-motivation, social skills, improved study skills, and overall student safety in a FUN drug-free, supervised environment.
