



2020-21 Student Suspension Rate

Disaggregated by Student Ethnicity and Student Group

Suspension rates are computed by dividing the number of suspended students by the total cumulative number of students. Suspended student counts are unduplicated such that students who are suspended more than once are counted once.

Cumulative enrollment consists of all primary and short-term enrollments within the academic year and is unduplicated at the district-level, such that students who attended multiple schools are only counted once in the districtwide figures.
