What is dual credit?

Dual credit is when a student is a high school student and a college student at the same time.

Students are able to earn their high school credit and college credit with their dual credit class.

What classes do we offer

- English 3 (Freshman Composition 1301&1302)

- U.S. History (1301&1302)
- Art Appreciation

AP vs. DC

Advanced Placement

- Take AP test to earn college credit
- College credit transferable throughout the United State
- 1.2 GPA Boost

Dual Credit

- Pass the course to earn college credit
- Not guarantee to transfer outside of Texas
- 1.1 GPA Boost

Step 1: Fill out the Dual Credit Interest Form

I cannot take students through the dual credit process if I don't know that they are interested in taking dual credit classes

Step 2: Do the Apply Texas application

Once students have filled out the interest form, I will take them through the Apply Texas application.

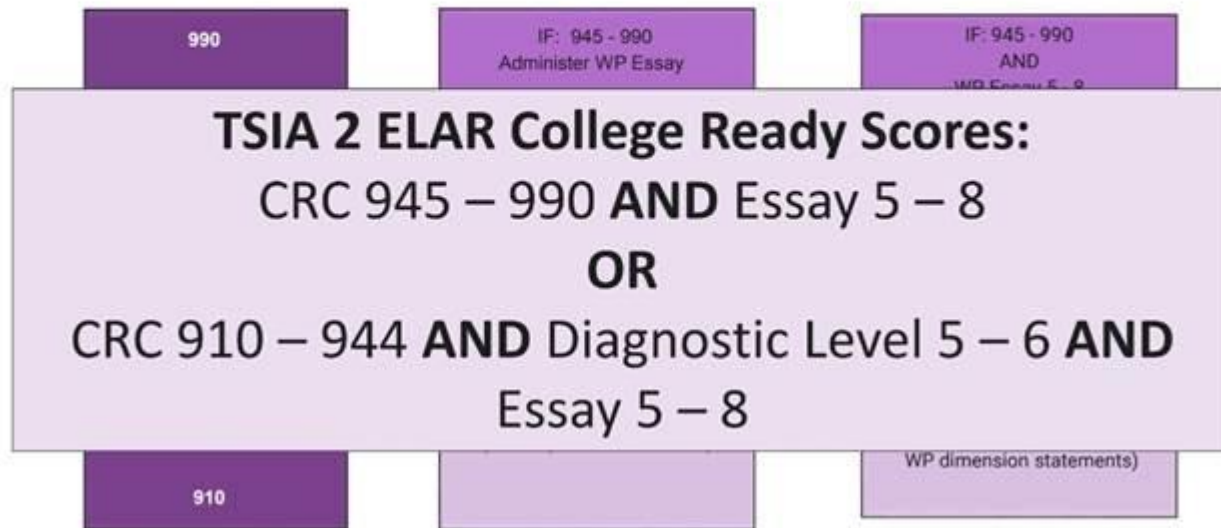

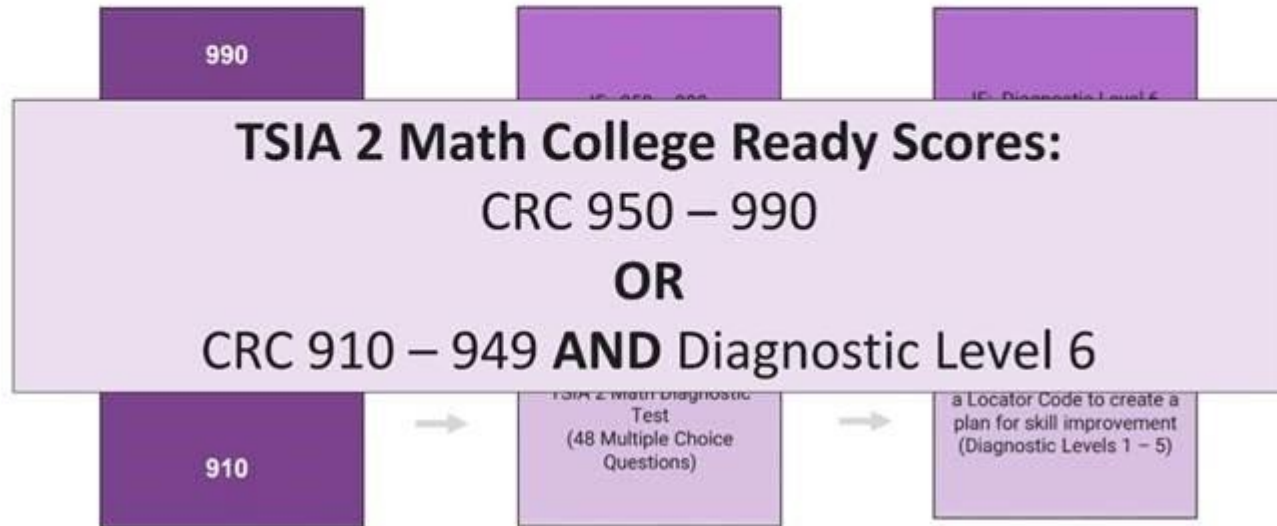
New TSIA2 ELAR Scores
