Policy 502.01 – Resident Student – The following paragraph was added to the current policy to ensure we are in agreement with the state statues dealing with how we handle ward of state Students:

*Any student who is a ward of the state or court, or who is residing in a residential setting in the district for reasons other than to receive an education shall be provided educational services in accordance with state statute 79-215 including such reimbursement to the district as may be due under the statute.*

Policy 801.04 – Bus Safety Procedures – language was changed on 801.04 corresponding to the new Rule 91 requirement for guidelines for the functional capacity of a pupil transportation driver and a process to confirm a driver's ability to conduct daily tasks. It was moved by Loseke and seconded by Jaixen to waive first reading of Policy 502.01 and Policy 801.04 and adopt as presented. On roll call vote, 6-0, motion carried.

1. Mrs. Krienke will report on Math Essentials grant program/course.

3. Sept 25<sup>th</sup>-26<sup>th</sup> Parent Teacher Conferences.
4. On the night of Monday, Sept 30<sup>th</sup>, 5:30 Education Quest is hosting FAFSA event from 6:00-8:00 at Lakeview Jr-Sr High. The FAFSA presentation is set up to help senior parents and students fill out the FAFSA. Education Quest rotates this presentation with all three schools in Columbus on an annual basis. This year Lakeview is hosting the event.
5. Business in Education Mock Interviews. All 11<sup>th</sup>/12<sup>th</sup> graders are scheduled to prepare a resume and participate in 2 mock interviews. Mrs. Dlouhy (Careers) and Mrs. Schaad (English 12/College English) prepare our Junior and Senior students on these skills.

**Section 10      Mid-Term Graduation**

Any student considering midterm graduation during his/her senior year must make a written request for midterm graduation prior to the beginning of his/her seventh semester of attendance. The request should include the reason(s) the student wishes to be considered for early separation. Upon receipt of the request, the counselor shall, within five working days, determine if the student will have met all the course requirements needed to graduate from Lakeview. If the student is on track to meet the requirements, the principal shall consider the request and shall, provide a recommendation for approval. The principal will then present the mid-term graduation list to the school board for approval. At the completion of the seventh semester, the student will not be allowed to participate in any other school activities or functions as a student. However, the student will have the option of participating in the commencement program at the end of the year.

➤ **Banking in Schools**

- The first Banking in Schools day was September 6 at Platte Center and Shell Creek
- 11 Students were interviewed for the teller positions at SC. Five will be chosen.
- 5 Students will be interviewed for teller positions at PC. Two to three will be chosen.

➤ **Title 1 Bingo Night**

- Bingo Night was held on August 26th at Lakeview.
- Over 125 people attended the event.
- Every student went home with a new book and school supplies.

➤ **NE Reads**

- Mr. Witt and Mrs. Craven presented the basics of the NE Reads Act to parents at the Title I Bingo
  - Students not meeting benchmark will be put into interventions to help increase achievement.
    - Focus is on K-3 - we will include 4-6
  - Communication with parents will take place within 15 days of benchmarking - parent teacher conferences.
  - These practices are already in place - modified to meet state requirements.

➤ **Parent Teacher Conferences**

- Conferences will be held on September 25th from 4-8 PM and September 26th from 2-7 PM.
- We are in the process of scheduling conferences for each family
- The goal is for 100% of parents to attend conferences.

➤ **Student Recognition Postcards**

- Teachers at both Shell Creek and Platte Center have continued sending out Positive Student Recognition Postcards to families weekly.

- Embargoed NSCAS General, NSCAS Alternate, and ACT reports have been released to districts.
- This data will be available to the public on October 9.

➤ Acadience (Formerly DIBELS) Testing

- All K-6 students will be given the Acadience Test on Sept 12, 13, 16
- This tests measures letter recognition, reading fluency, and comprehension.

➤ MAP Testing

- The fall MAP testing window is currently open.
  - K-2 Students will take tests in Reading & Math
  - 3-8 Students will take tests in Reading, Language, Math
  - 4th, 5th, 7th, & 8th will take tests in Science.

➤ **Homecoming Week**

- Students will be encouraged to participate in the Spirit Week dress themes each day.
- High School sports teams will be visiting the elementary buildings each morning throughout the week. The teams introduce themselves and share information about their sport as well as other school spirit and character items.
