#### 5.1 Administrative Reports:

- 5.1 Superintendent Dr. Plas gave a report on the 32,428 meals served by the Nutrition Services staff during the closure, re-opening information on the weight room, summer school, graduation, and sports/activities, bond selling, construction, vehicle inventory, and the CARES act.
  - Dr. Plas reported that Lakeview has received an AA- bond rating, which was the best case scenario for the district. \$8,000,000 in bonds will be sold next week.
  - Dr. Plas gave a report on the vehicle fleet for the district. There are currently 18 vehicles/buses in the district and they traveled a combined 119,054 in 2019-20.
