➤ **Brought Up Grades (B.U.G) Awards**

- Each school will be giving out BUG awards.
- Students who have improved their grades since the 1st quarter will be awarded a pencil, sticker, and certificate.

➤ **Professional Development Day in York**

- On January 21st all certified teachers will be attending the York MLK Conference. This conference has two keynote speakers along with breakout sessions from various area educators. (see the attached schedule)

➤ **Parent Teacher Conferences**

➤ **ELPA21 Testing**

- Window Opens February 4th and runs through March 15th.
- The ELPA21 assessment system measures and reports on student's English language proficiency overall, as well as reading, writing, speaking, listening, and comprehension skills.

➤ **Food Drive**

- Shell Creek Student Council sponsored a Food Drive prior to Christmas Break. They donated over 500 items to the Columbus Food Pantry

➤ **English Language Arts (ELA) Selection Process Update**

- Teachers have reviewed the top resources and completed the rubric for each resource.
- Textbook Representatives were at Shell Creek on Dec. 21 from 8:00-1:30 to share information with teachers, parents, and administration about their product and answer questions about the resources.
- We have narrowed our focus to the following resources.

- A site visit team of 5 teachers has been assembled, and we will visit schools using our final three resources before making a final decision.

- College Week will take place at both Platte Center and Shell Creek Elementary Schools during the week of February 11. We are currently working with Kara Assmus (Drive for Five Coordinator) to plan the week.
- Many events will happen throughout the week including a campus tour at CCC, a mock graduation, a college student panel, and other activities to promote students to think about post secondary education.

➤ **NDE Safety Audit**

- Both elementary schools took part in a safety and security audit on January 8th. Staff was randomly interviewed to gather information about safety and security procedures at both buildings. Both schools had one area of improvement noted. The rooms numbers will need to be placed on the classroom exterior windows. He complimented the staff on the overall safety preparation and the general condition of the buildings.
