- 6.1 Consent Agenda – It was moved by Pabian and seconded by Loseke to approve the consent agenda as presented. On roll call vote, 6-0, motion carried.
- 6.2 Approval of Resignations – It was moved by Sprunk and seconded by Jaixen to approve the resignation of Kathy Brunt as Title I/ESL Teacher at Shell Creek on roll call vote, 6-0, motion carried. It was moved by Pabian and seconded by Sprunk to approve the resignation of Melissa Rutten as Night Time Custodian @Lakeview. On roll call vote, 6-0, motion carried.
- 6.3 Approval of New Hires – It was moved by Loseke and seconded by Sprunk to approve Amy Eisenmenger as HS English Teacher/Speech Coach at Lakeview, Emily Vales as Agriculture Education Teacher/FFA Sponsor at Lakeview, and Jacob Brand as HS SPED Teacher at Lakeview. On roll call vote, 6-0, motion carried. It was moved by Pabian and seconded by Jaixen to approve Mollie Shevlin as K-8 School Counselor and Dan Krueger as JH Activities Director. On roll call vote, 6-0, motion carried.
- 6.4 Discuss, consider and take all necessary action with regard to (1) the selection of the Construction Management at Risk (CM@R) method of construction delivery for the proposed renovation and additions to the Lakeview Jr./Sr. High School building to be constructed on the existing high school building and grounds owned and operated by the School District located in Platte County, Nebraska under the Political Subdivisions Construction Alternatives Act, Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 13-2901, (the "Act") conditioned on the passage of a bond issue election to finance such Project; and, (2) the adoption of Board of Education policies required to implement the CM@R process under the Act. - It was moved Loseke and seconded by Sprunk to approve of Construction Manager at Risk construction delivery method as presented, direct the

superintendent to prepare a request for proposals, and approval of policy 902.05 with the waiving of second reading. On roll call vote, 6-0, motion carried.

- 6.5 Approval of Contract with Mid-State Busing for 2019-20 through 2021-22 - The cost will increase 3.0% each of the three years. Lakeview has been pleased with the service and responsiveness by Mid-States throughout the last few years. It was moved by Jaixen and seconded by Pabian to approve the 2019-20 through 2021-22 contract for busing services with Mid-State School Bus Inc. On roll call vote, 6-0, motion carried.
- 6.6 Approval of the 2019-20 School Calendar – It was moved by Sprunk and seconded by Pabian to approve the 2019-20 school calendar as presented. On roll call vote, 6-0, motion carried.
- 6.7 Approval of the Printer Lease Agreement with Eakes Office Supply - Lakeview contracts into a printer lease agreement for our printers and copiers throughout the district every five years. It was discussed that Lakeview will reduce from 11 Multi-Function Printers to 8 Multi-Function Printers. The previous lease agreement cost us \$222,705 over the previous five years and this total lease package will cost \$152,849 over five years. It was moved by Pabian and seconded by Sprunk to approve the Eakes Printer Lease Agreement as presented by the Technology Committee. On roll call vote, 6-0, motion carried.
- 6.8 Approval of 2019-20 ESU 7 SPED Service Contract – Dr Plas presented the proposed contract. The cost for 2019-20 is proposed at \$308,034. It was moved by Loseke and seconded by Pabian to approve the ESU7 SPED Services Contract for 2019-20 as presented. On roll call vote, 6-0, motion carried.
- 6.9 Approval of Superintendent Contract – It was moved by Jaixen and seconded by Sprunk to approve the superintendent contract for 2019-20 and 2020-21. On roll call vote, 6-0, motion carried.

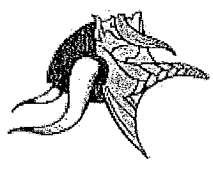

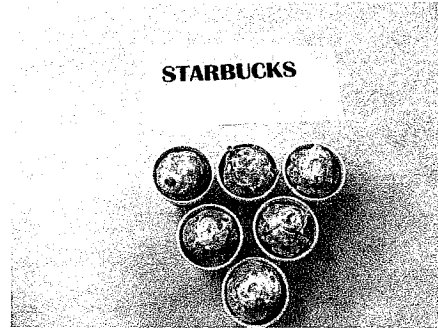
Cupcake Wars


