

# What is Concurrent English?

Concurrent ENGL 1203 & 1213 are University of Arkansas - Fort Smith college-level courses.



Concurrent programs allow students to be enrolled in two separate, academically related institutions; therefore, it is critical that students enrolled in ENGL 1203/1213 understand course specifics:

- ENGL 1203 provides dual enrollment of college-level English Composition 1 AND high school-level Junior OR Senior English.
- ENGL 1213 provides dual enrollment of college-level English Composition 2 AND high school-level Junior OR Senior English.
- Please Note: *Students may only continue to English Comp 2 with a "C" or above in Comp 1, ENGL 1203.*

# Course Descriptions

## ENGL 1203

- Compose pieces of writing that are unified, coherent, and well-developed.
- Edit one's own writing for conventions of standard usage and style.
- Compose pieces of writing that properly use and incorporate credible source material.
- Format writing assignments and document use of source material following MLA conventions.

## ENGL 1213

- Compose pieces of writing that are unified, coherent, and well-developed.
- Edit one's own writing for conventions of standard usage and style.
- Use library databases and other academic research methods to locate credible source material.
- Compose pieces of writing that properly use and incorporate credible source material.
- Format writing assignments and document use of source material following MLA and APA conventions.

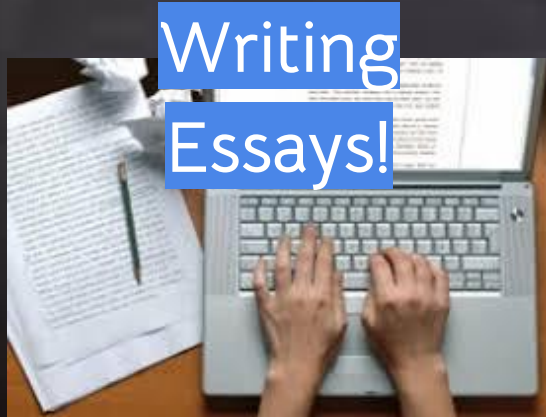

- Additionally, for placement, an ACT score of 19 is required in Reading and English.
