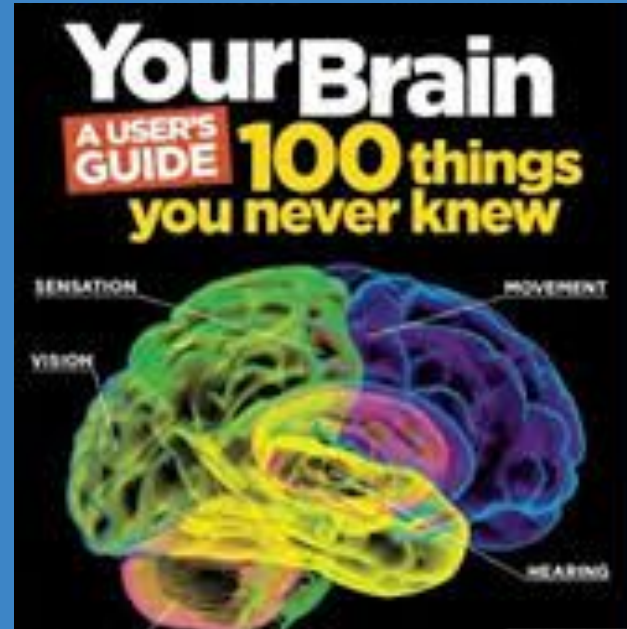

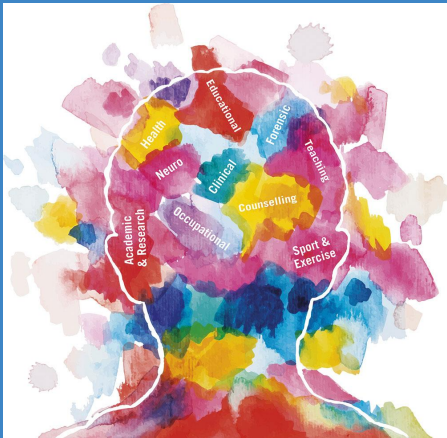
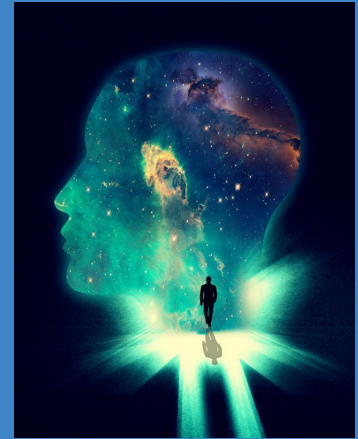
**In the last 3 years, nearly 90% of Southside AP Psych students passed the exam. 40% received 5's - the highest possible score!**
