The required video must be submitted via email to lilliejmadisonscholarship1920@gmail.com; all hard copy materials must be postmarked by **Saturday, April, 20, 2024**. The Scholarship Committee will review all submissions and select the winner(s) by **Saturday, May 4, 2024**. The winner(s) will be notified upon selection.

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ESSAY/VIDEO GUIDELINES

Applicant please submit your type-written and signed **Lillie J. Madison Memorial Scholarship Application**, along with your completed essay to the address provided in the instructions. Utilize the following guidelines for your essay and video:

ESSAY REQUIREMENT:

- Essay must be formatted with 1 inch margins, double-spaced, Times New Roman font style, size 12 font, and font color black.
- Essay must be typed, well written, utilizing correct English, spelling, and grammar.
- Essay must contain five completed paragraphs with no less than 500 and no more than 1200 words.
- In your essay, discuss the following:
 - What is community service?
 - What does community service mean to you and why?
 - Identify an organization that provides resources to those in need in your community.
 - What suggestions can you provide on how to bring awareness about the organization?
 - What talents/services can you provide to assist the community service organization's mission?
 - How do you feel about community service in your future?

VIDEO REQUIREMENT:

- Record a five (5) minute but no more than seven (7) minutes and 20 seconds video of yourself narrating your essay.
 - Professional attire required
 - Appropriate recording area/background required.
 - Upload your video to Youtube and email the link to lilliejmadisonscholarship1920@gmail.com. Please ensure that you select “unlisted” as your privacy setting.
 - In the subject box of your email, type your LAST NAME, FIRST NAME VIDEO SUBMISSION.
