2. <u>Authorization to Submit Proposition to Qualified Voters for the establishment of a Capital Reserve Fund</u>:

Be it resolved that the Frankfort-Schuyler Central School District Board of Education hereby authorized a proposition to be submitted to voters at the annual school district election to be held on May 17, 2022, and to include as part of the notice of the annual district meeting and election notice, for the creation of a Capital Reserve Fund as follows:

Shall the Board of Education of the Frankfort- Schuyler Central School District, be authorized to establish a Capital Reserve Fund for a ten-year term pursuant to Section 3651 of the **Education Law** and fund such fund in an amount not to exceed \$6,000,000, inclusive of accrued interest and other investment earnings, to be used for renovations and additions to all District facilities, including purchase of equipment, technology upgrades, classroom equipment and/or school infrastructure equipment, site development, athletic fields, storm and sanitary sewer, driveways, and parking lots, such reserve fund to be funded from (i) year-end budget surplus funds known as unassigned fund balance, as available, for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2022 and each fiscal year thereafter for the term of the reserve fund, (ii) transfers of excess monies from Board of Education designated reserves, (iii) amounts from budgetary appropriations from time to time, and (iv) New York State Aid received and made available by the Board of Education from time to time, all as permitted by law.

3. <u>Approved Proposed Contract between Superintendent of Schools and Frankfort-Schuyler C.S.E.A.,</u> Local 1000 AFSCME, AFL-CIO:

Be it resolved that the Frankfort-Schuyler Central School District Board of Education hereby approved the proposed contract between the Superintendent of Schools and the Frankfort-Schuyler C.S.E.A., Local 1000 AFSCME, AFL-CIO, extending from July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2025, as presented.
