- a. Carol Strong Nelson brought her concerns of the dangers regarding plans for a sidewalk along Dart Road and across West Street. Discussion took place.
- b. Tara Trapp, 49 East Street, brought her concerns regarding the stop sign on East Street near Northeast School and the disregard of signage. Discussion took place.
- c. Dan Wasilewski brought an unofficial complaint about the Dispensary on Talcottville Road, which sits on the frontage of a state road. The GPS coordinates bring drivers through the Exit Only drive on Rt 83, and drivers are using the access road by condos. Dispensary owners are aware of the problem and are installing more *Do Not Enter* signs on the 83 side as well as in the parking lot. The Condo Association has been notified that the town is trying to improve safety and that they could attend a scheduled TA meeting regarding the issue.
- d. Discussion took place regarding signs by Tunnel Road, installed by state.
