# **BUS RIDER RULES**

#### A. GENERAL:

- 1. Parents and pupils must realize that school bus transportation is a privilege, not a right.
- 2. Be informed that misbehavior of any kind will not be tolerated. Pupils who misbehave can be suspended from school and can be denied the privilege of riding on the bus.

# B. PREVIOUS TO LOADING: (on the road and at the school)

- 1. Be on time at the designated school bus stops help keep the bus on schedule.
- 2. Stay off the road while waiting for the bus. Bus riders should conduct themselves in a safe manner while waiting.
- 3. Wait until the bus comes to a complete stop before attempting to board the bus. Line up in an orderly, single file manner. Do not rush to get on the bus.
- 4. Be courteous. Don't take advantage of younger children in order to get a seat on the bus.
- 5. If there is no sidewalk or path, it is recommended that you walk to the side of the road facing traffic to get to the bus stop.
- 6. Use the handrail and watch your step with boarding and exiting the bus.

#### C. WHILE ON THE BUS:

- 1. Keep hand and head inside the bus at all times.
- 2. Assist in keeping the bus safe and sanitary at all times.
- 3. Remember, loud talking and laughing or unnecessary confusion diverts the driver's attention and may result in an accident.
- 4. Treat bus equipment as valuable furniture in your home. Damage to seats, etc., must be paid for by the offender.
- 5. Never tamper with the bus or any of its equipment.
- 6. Leave no books, packages, coats or other objects on the bus.
- 7. Keep books, packages, coats and all other objects out of the aisles.
- 8. Remain in the bus in case of road emergency, unless directed to do otherwise by the bus driver.
- 9. Do not throw anything out of the bus window.
- 10. Always be courteous to fellow pupils, bus driver, the driver's assistant and to passerby's.
- 11. Always remain in your seat while the bus is in motion.
- 12. Parents will be notified if there is continuous misconduct on the bus. Bus riders may be denied the privilege of riding.
- 13. Keep absolutely quiet when approaching a railroad crossing.
- 14. The driver is responsible for controlling the bus riders. Riders must obey him/her promptly and cheerfully.
- 15. Inform the driver, if possible, when a rider will be absent.

### D. AFTER LEAVING THE BUS:

- 1. Cross the road at least 10 feet in front of the bus, but only after checking to be sure there is no traffic approaching and/or after receiving a signal from the driver.
- 2. Help look after the safety and comfort of small children.

## E. EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITY TRIPS:

- 1. The above rules and regulations will apply to any trip under school sponsorship.
- 2. Pupils shall respect the wishes of competent chaperones appointed by the school officials to accompany the bus riders.
