STUDENT-ATHLETE EXPECTATIONS:

Academic Performance

NBSD requires that participants must be passing a minimum of five classes in order to be eligible for competitions/events/performances (they may attend practices). Students below the standard will be placed on probation and required to attend study table.



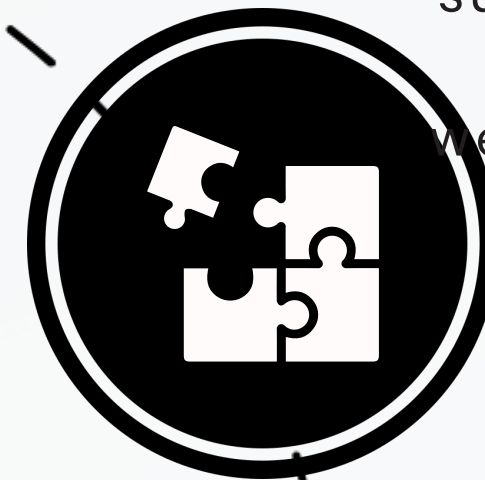
Attendance

Students must be present, checked into school, a minimum of 5 class periods to participate in practice or contests/events/games/performances.



Chemical Use

The North Beach School District takes a strong position regarding the use of these substances and has a policy to address offenders. It is the belief of the advisor/coaching staff, teachers and administration that the use of these substances is detrimental to the student's health and welfare and not conducive to maximize performance of participants.



ELIGIBILITY

Without meeting the eligibility requirements, students will not participate:

Students must be regular members of the school they represent in order to participate in an interscholastic athletic activity. Students are a “regular member” of a school if they are enrolled half time or more, exclusive of interscholastic athletic activities. (WIAA 18.5.0)

ENROLLMENT

Prior to the first day of practice of an interscholastic sport, participants must undergo a physical examination or a signed statement from a medical authority as defined by the WIAA (17.11.2). The exam will be valid for a period of 24 consecutive months from the time of the examination.

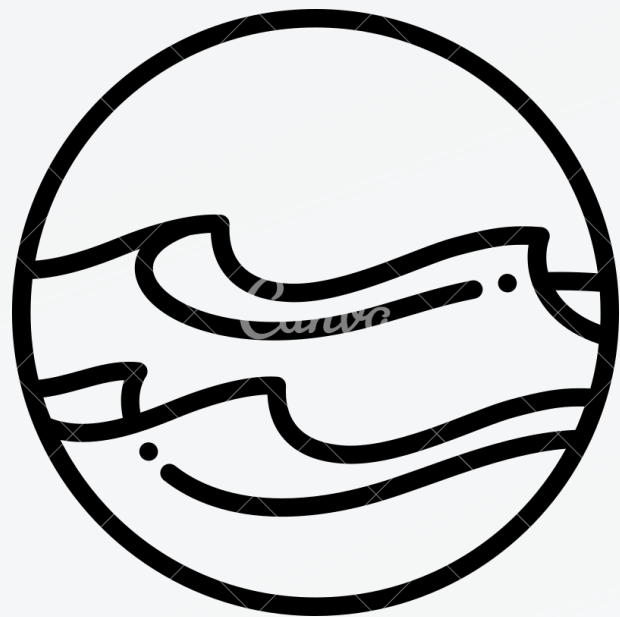
PHYSICAL EXAM

Registration is completed for each sport an individual participates in, each season. Students cannot practice and prepare for the season without the registration.

School Wide

A student-athlete shall follow all relevant rules established by the North Beach School District while they are eligible or potentially eligible to participate in extra-curricular activities, including, but not limited to time, such as summer breaks, vacations, and non-school days, and regardless of whether the student athlete is not currently participating in an activity/sport. Failure to follow these rules may result in activity/athletic discipline consequences include, but not limited to loss of playing time, suspension, or dismissal following a review by the school's administration.



DISCIPLINE: VIOLATION TO THE CODE OF CONDUCT

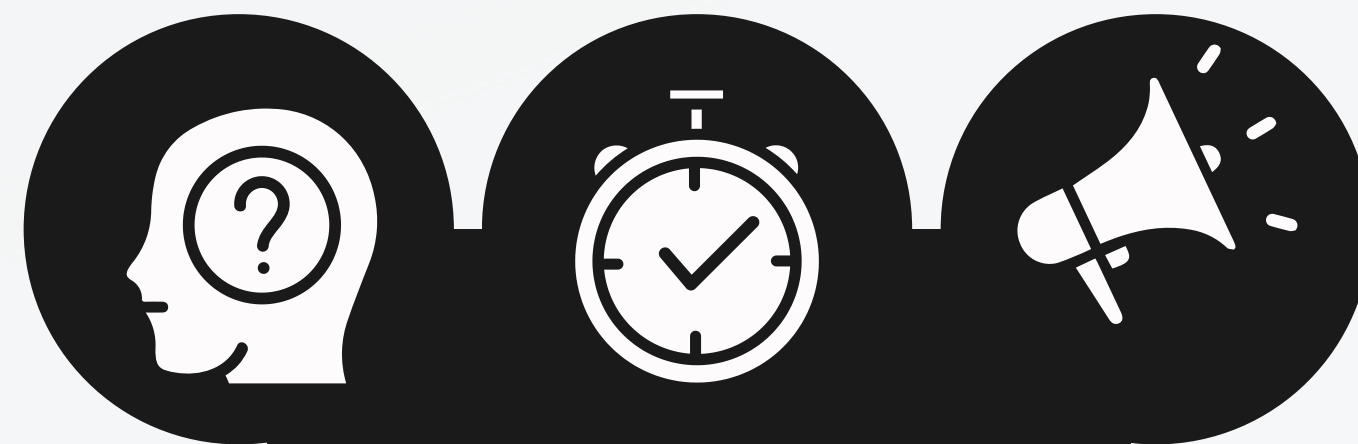
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- Any misconduct by a student that affects the team, coach, school or school district may result in disciplinary action. The extent of the action will be determined by the nature of the offense.
 - Prior to any action resulting in a suspension from a team, there will be a parent meeting with the student, advisor/coach and the school administration.
 - Upon the imposition of penalty for infractions of rules or regulations, any aggrieved student and parents of said student shall have the right to an informal conference with Athletic Director to request that they refrain from enforcing the decision of the advisor/ coach (appeal process).



SPORTSMANSHIP

NBSD students, families, sponsors and fans representing our district are expected to display exemplary levels of sportsmanship during all school sponsored sanctioned events.
