What does a Native Education Coordinator do?

Oversees and protects the integrity, sustainability and growth of the Title VI Program.

NO CHILD LEFT BEHIND ACT

The Title VI Grant through the State of Washington. US Department of Education specifically allocates funds for the culturally related academic needs of Indian children, including their language and cultural needs.

American Indian and Alaskan Natives are defined through the grant language as:

- 1.A member of an Indian tribe or band, as membership is defined by the Indian tribe or band, including any tribe or band terminated since 1940, and any tribe or band recognized by the State in which the tribe or band resides;
- 2.A descendant of a parent or grandparent who meets the requirements described in paragraph of this definition;
- 3. Considered by the Secretary of the Interior to be an Indian for any purpose;
- 4.An Eskimo, Aleut, or other Alaska Native.
