

- Do you provide care for children that qualify for North Dakota Child Care Assistance Program (CCAP)?
  - Do any of those children have special needs?

## If so... you may qualify for an additional 10% increase in monthly assistance.

Families that qualify for the Childcare Assistance Program in North Dakota and the child has been determined to have a special need, may also qualify for the provider to receive an additional 10% increase in their monthly assistance.

### How does this work?

- A parent can fill out the Childcare Assistance Program application at <https://www.hhs.nd.gov/applyforhelp>.
- If qualified, parents can contact their *Human Service Zone eligibility worker* and let them know they would like to submit information along with the application to show the need for the increased rate.

### What information is needed?

Written verification is required and should state the nature of the special needs and if for a child aged thirteen (13) or under.

- ✓ A qualified health professional, a physician, physician's assistant, advanced registered nurse practitioner, qualified mental health professional as defined by KRS 600.020 (48) or registered nurse defined by KRS 314.011(5).
- ✓ A court order or similar documentation indicating the child is under court supervision.
- ✓ An Individual Education Program (IEP) provided by the school or an Individual Family Service Plan IFSP.
- If a family is currently receiving CCAP, the parent needs to contact their Human Service Zone eligibility worker and provide the information listed above.

## Income Limits for CCAP
