

PTO Meeting Minutes
November 9, 2021 – 6:30pm – School Library

Beth was out ill. Tricia presented the last meeting's minutes. Tricia made a motion to accept, Christy 2nd. Motion carried.

Leesa presented the treasurers report. Teacher stipends were given Monday. Christy made a motion to accept as presented, Tricia 2nd. Motion carried.
